This memo will serve as an interim policy update to [WIOAPL 19-01 Implementation of Workforce Development Services Under the Opioid Emergency Recovery Grant](#). The following presents one change to the current policy that are effective on the date of this memo.

The U.S. Department of Labor has approved a modification to Ohio's Opioid Emergency Recovery Grant. This modification will allow participants in Temporary Disaster Relief Jobs to work a maximum of 4080 hours. This new maximum limit supersedes the 2040-hour limit currently outlined in WIOAPL 19-01.
