

MONTHLY REVIEW OF PUBLIC ASSISTANCE STATISTICS FOR JANUARY 2004

OHIO WORKS FIRST

For the month of January 2004, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 86,527; recipients totaled 193,097 and money payments totaled \$26,260,851. The percent change from December 2003 to January 2004 was -1.6% for assistance groups; -2.0% for recipients, and -2.8% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 82,463 assistance groups; 176,525 recipients, and \$24,617,828 in money payments issued for January 2004. The percent change from December 2003 to January 2004 was -1.8% for assistance groups; -2.2% for recipients, and -3.0% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U) assistance groups totaled 4,064; recipients, 16,572, and money payments were \$1,643,023. The percent change from December 2003 to January 2004 was 1.0% for assistance groups; 0.7% for recipients and 0.4% for money payments.

FOSTER CARE (TITLE IV-E)

A total of 25,742 children received \$12,754,750 in Title IV-E assistance during the month of January 2004. Included in this total were 6,919 foster care children who received \$5,725,619 in money payments. Of these Title IV-E children, 2,895 or 11.2% were in foster family homes who received \$1,274,453 and 4,024 or 15.6% children in child care institutions who received \$4,451,166 in OWF foster care assistance. The remaining 18,823 children reported as participating in Title IV-E received \$7,029,132 in adoption assistance. Overall, the average amount of Foster Care received per child was \$495.48.

DISABILITY ASSISTANCE (DA)

For the month of January 2004, there were 12,644 assistance groups; 12,762 recipients, and \$1,633,608 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$128.01. Total DA expenditures for medical services for January 2004 were \$ 5,825,099. Of this total, \$3,982,319 or 68.4% was spent for prescribed drugs, and \$1,512,838 or 26.0% was spent for physician services. Medical expenses were paid for 14,977 recipients for an average expenditure of \$ 388.94 per recipient.

FNS BENEFITS:


Total persons participating in the FNS benefits program during January 2004 decreased to 930,391 by 5,379 or -0.6% from 935,770 persons reported in December 2003. Households decreased by 2,591 or -0.6% over December 2003 levels. The total dollar value of FNS related benefits issued during January 2004 decreased by \$2,030,107 or -2.4% from \$83,581,169 reported in December 2003 to \$81,551,062 reported in January 2004. The average benefit issuance per person decreased by \$1.67 or -1.9% from those issued in December 2003. The average benefit issuance per person decreased from \$89.32 in December 2003 to \$87.65 in January 2004.

Please note: All data in the PAMS report is limited to the information available at the time it was constructed. It does not account for backdated or retroactive eligibility or any adjustments made subsequent to its creation.



During the Last 25 Months




Number of OWF-Combined Recipients During the Last 25 Months




DA Cash Assistance Groups




Number of FNS Benefits Assist. Groups
