

MONTHLY REVIEW OF PUBLIC ASSISTANCE STATISTICS FOR FEBRUARY 2003

OHIO WORKS FIRST

For the month of February 2003, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 86,172; recipients totaled 194,278 and money payments totaled \$25,980,395. The percent change from January 2003 to February 2003 was -1.3% for assistance groups; -1.6% for recipients, and -0.5% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 82,048 assistance groups; 177,379 recipients, and \$24,357,664 in money payments issued for February 2003. The percent change from January 2003 to February 2003 was -1.3% for assistance groups; -1.7% for recipients, and -0.5% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U) assistance groups totaled 4,124; recipients 16,899, and money payments were \$1,622,731. The percent change from January 2003 to February 2003 was -0.9% for assistance groups; -1.4% for recipients and -0.2% for money payments.

FOSTER CARE (TITLE IV-E)

A total of 24,080 children received \$12,009,081 in Title IV-E assistance during the month of February 2003. Included in this total were 6,352 foster care children who received \$5,458,125 in money payments. Of these Title IV-E children, 3,165 or 13.1% were in foster family homes who received \$1,282,052 and 3,187 or 13.2% children in child care institutions who received \$4,176,073 in OWF foster care assistance. The remaining 17,728 children reported as participating in Title IV-E received \$6,550,956 in adoption assistance. Overall, the average amount of Foster Care received per child was \$498.72.

DISABILITY ASSISTANCE (DA)

For the month of February 2003, there were 15,745 assistance groups; 16,159 recipients, and \$1,940,964 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$120.12. Total DA expenditures for medical services for February 2003 were \$7,178,384. Of this total, \$4,920,712 or 68.5% was spent for prescribed drugs, and \$1,849,915 or 25.8% was spent for physician services. Medical expenses were paid for 20,088 recipients for an average expenditure of \$357.35 per recipient.


FNS BENEFITS: UPDATE

Total persons participating in the FNS benefits program during February 2003 decreased to 835,650 by 5,673 or - 0.7% from 841,323 persons reported in January 2003. Households decreased by 2,399 or -0.6% over January 2003 levels. The total dollar value of FNS related benefits issued during February 2003 increased by \$ 175,918 or 0.2% from \$70,756,684 reported in January 2003 to \$70,932,602 reported in February 2003. The average benefit issuance per person increased by \$.78 or 0.9% from those issued in January 2003. The average benefit issuance per person increased from \$84.10 in January 2003 to \$84.88 in February 2003.



During the Last 25 Months




Number of OWF-Combined Recipients During the Last 25 Months




DA Cash Assistance Groups




Number of FNS Benefits Assist. Groups
