

MONTHLY REVIEW OF PUBLIC ASSISTANCE STATISTICS FOR MARCH 2003

OHIO WORKS FIRST

For the month of March 2003, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 86,263; recipients totaled 194,443 and money payments totaled \$25,929,400. The percent change from February 2003 to March 2003 was 0.1% for assistance groups; 0.1% for recipients, and -0.2% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 82,065 assistance groups; 177,267 recipients, and \$24,293,390 in money payments issued for March 2003. The percent change from February 2003 to March 2003 was 0.0% for assistance groups; -0.1% for recipients, and -0.3% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U) assistance groups totaled 4,198; recipients 17,176, and money payments were \$1,636,010. The percent change from February 2003 to March 2003 was 1.8% for assistance groups; 1.6% for recipients and 0.8% for money payments.

FOSTER CARE (TITLE IV-E)

A total of 24,866 children received \$12,846,053 in Title IV-E assistance during the month of March 2003. Included in this total were 7,065 foster care children who received \$6,283,865 in money payments. Of these Title IV-E children, 3,188 or 12.8% were in foster family homes who received \$1,429,669 and 3,877 or 15.6% children in child care institutions who received \$4,854,196 in OWF foster care assistance. The remaining 17,801 children reported as participating in Title IV-E received \$6,562,188 in adoption assistance. Overall, the average amount of Foster Care received per child was \$516.61.

DISABILITY ASSISTANCE (DA)

For the month of March 2003, there were 16,148 assistance groups; 16,553 recipients, and \$2,014,058 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$121.67. Total DA expenditures for medical services for March 2003 were \$7,527,672. Of this total, \$5,168,485 or 68.7% was spent for prescribed drugs, and \$1,924,543 or 25.6% was spent for physician services. Medical expenses were paid for 20,513 recipients for an average expenditure of \$366.97 per recipient.


FNS BENEFITS:

Total persons participating in the FNS benefits program during March 2003 increased to 859,754 by 24,104 or 2.9% from 835,650 persons reported in February 2003. Households increased by 11,165 or 3.0% over February 2003 levels. The total dollar value of FNS related benefits issued during March 2003 increased by \$ 3,554,415 or 5.0% from \$70,932,602 reported in February 2003 to \$74,487,017 reported in March 2003. The average benefit issuance per person increased by \$ 1.76 or 2.1% from those issued in February 2003. The average benefit issuance per person increased from \$84.88 in February 2003 to \$86.64 in March 2003.



During the Last 25 Months




Number of OWF-Combined Recipients During the Last 25 Months




DA Cash Assistance Groups




Number of FNS Benefits Assist. Groups
