

MONTHLY REVIEW OF PUBLIC ASSISTANCE STATISTICS FOR JUNE 2002

OHIO WORKS FIRST

For the month of June 2002, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 83,958; recipients totaled 190,295 and money payments totaled \$25,557,133. The percent change from May 2002 to June 2002 was -2.1% for assistance groups; -2.7% for recipients, and -2.7% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 80,451 assistance groups; 175,697 recipients, and \$24,200,171 in money payments issued for June 2002. The percent change from May 2002 to June 2002 was -1.9% for assistance groups; -2.3% for recipients, and -2.4% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U) assistance groups totaled 3,507; recipients 14,598, and money payments were \$1,356,962. The percent change from May 2002 to June 2002 was -7.0% for assistance groups; -7.0% for recipients and -8.6% for money payments.

FOSTER CARE (TITLE IV-E)

A total of 24,284 children received \$13,142,383 in Title IV-E assistance during the month of June 2002. Included in this total were 7,539 foster care children who received \$7,112,376 in money payments. Of these Title IV-E children, 3,320 or 13.7% were in foster family homes who received \$1,383,628 and 4,219 or 17.4% children in child care institutions who received \$5,728,748 in OWF foster care assistance. The remaining 16,745 children reported as participating in Title IV-E received \$6,030,007 in adoption assistance. Overall, the average amount of Foster Care received per child was \$541.20.

DISABILITY ASSISTANCE (DA)

For the month of June 2002, there were 12,850 assistance groups; 13,214 recipients, and \$1,634,116 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$123.67. Total DA expenditures for medical services for June 2002 were \$4,868,015. Of this total, \$3,236,417 or 66.5% was spent for prescribed drugs, and \$ 1,322,948 or 27.2% was spent for physician services. Medical expenses were paid for 17,058 recipients for an average expenditure of \$285.38 per recipient.


FNS BENEFITS:

Total persons participating in the FNS benefits program during June 2002 decreased to 744,545 by 215 or -0.0% from 744,760 persons reported in May 2002. Households decreased by 1,327 or -0.4% over May 2002 levels. The total dollar value of FNS related benefits issued during June 2002 decreased by \$712,320 or -1.2% from \$61,401,111 reported in May 2002 to \$60,688,791 reported in June 2002. The average benefit issuance per person decreased by \$.93 or -1.1% from those issued in May 2002. The average benefit issuance per person decreased from \$82.44 in May 2002 to \$81.51 in June 2002.



During the Last 25 Months




Number of OWF-Combined Recipients During the Last 25 Months




DA Cash Assistance Groups




Number of FNS Benefits Assist. Groups
