

MONTHLY REVIEW OF PUBLIC ASSISTANCE STATISTICS FOR JUNE 2003

OHIO WORKS FIRST

For the month of June 2003, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 85,570; recipients totaled 190,825 and money payments totaled \$25,945,249. The percent change from May 2003 to June 2003 was -1.2% for assistance groups; -1.6% for recipients, and -0.7% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 81,816 assistance groups; 175,468 recipients, and \$24,469,304 in money payments issued for June 2003. The percent change from May 2003 to June 2003 was -0.9% for assistance groups; -1.1% for recipients, and -0.3% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U) assistance groups totaled 3,754; recipients 15,357, and money payments were \$1,475,945. The percent change from May 2003 to June 2003 was -7.3% for assistance groups; -7.5% for recipients and -6.4% for money payments.

FOSTER CARE (TITLE IV-E)

A total of 25,562 children received \$13,205,397 in Title IV-E assistance during the month of June 2003. Included in this total were 7,535 foster care children who received \$6,566,266 in money payments. Of these Title IV-E children, 3,346 or 13.1% were in foster family homes who received \$1,470,298 and 4,189 or 16.4% children in child care institutions who received \$5,095,968 in OWF foster care assistance. The remaining 18,027 children reported as participating in Title IV-E received \$6,639,131 in adoption assistance. Overall, the average amount of Foster Care received per child was \$516.60.

DISABILITY ASSISTANCE (DA)

For the month of June 2003, there were 16,709 assistance groups; 17,114 recipients, and \$2,022,589 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$118.18. Total DA expenditures for medical services for June 2003 were \$7,732,402. Of this total, \$5,031,375 or 65.1% was spent for prescribed drugs, and \$2,115,137 or 27.4% was spent for physician services. Medical expenses were paid for 21,296 recipients for an average expenditure of \$363.09 per recipient.


FNS BENEFITS:

Total persons participating in the FNS benefits program during June 2003 increased to 887,138 by 16,959 or 1.9% from 870,179 persons reported in May 2003. Households increased by 7,143 or 1.9% over May 2003 levels. The total dollar value of FNS related benefits issued during June 2003 increased by \$ 2,043,061 or 2.8% from \$73,740,366 reported in May 2003 to \$75,783,427 reported in June 2003. The average benefit issuance per person increased by \$.68 or 0.8% from those issued in May 2003. The average benefit issuance per person increased from \$84.74 in May 2003 to \$85.42 in June 2003.



During the Last 25 Months




Number of OWF-Combined Recipients During the Last 25 Months




DA Cash Assistance Groups




Number of FNS Benefits Assist. Groups
