MONTHLY REVIEW OF PUBLIC ASSISTANCE STATISTICS FOR JUNE 2005

OHIO WORKS FIRST

For the month of June 2005, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 83,932; recipients totaled 182,698 and money payments totaled \$24,568,210. The percent change from May 2005 to June 2005 was 0.8% for assistance groups; 0.8% for recipients, and -1.7% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 80,020 assistance groups; 166,976 recipients, and \$23,094,088 in money payments issued for June 2005. The percent change from May 2005 to June 2005 was 0.9% for assistance groups; 1.0% for recipients, and -1.4% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U) assistance groups totaled 3,912; recipients, 15,722 and money payments were \$1,474,122. The percent change from May 2005 to June 2005 was -1.8% for assistance groups; -1.7% for recipients and -6.6% for money payments.

FOSTER CARE (TITLE IV-E)

A total of 27,143 children received \$14,010,354 in Title IV-E assistance during the month of June 2005. Included in this total were 7,153 foster care children who received \$6,420,540 in money payments. Of these Title IV-E children, 2,988 or 11.0% were in foster family homes who received \$1,241,856 and 4,165 or 15.3% children in child care institutions who received \$5,178,684 in OWF foster care assistance. The remaining 19,990 children reported as participating in Title IV-E received \$7,589,814 in adoption assistance. Overall, the average amount of Foster Care received per child was \$516.17.

DISABILITY ASSISTANCE (DA)

For the month of June 2005, there were 14,953 assistance groups; 15,055 recipients, and \$1,825,070 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$121.23. Total DA expenditures for medical services for June 2005 were \$ 5,355,279. Of this total, \$3,590,036 or 67.0% was spent for prescribed drugs, and \$1,393,203 or 26.0% was spent for physician services. Medical expenses were paid for 12,786 recipients for an average expenditure of \$418.84 per recipient.

FNS BENEFITS:


Total persons participating in the FNS benefits program during June 2005 decreased to 1,010,979 by 12,159 or -1.2% from 1,023,138 persons reported in May 2005. Households decreased by 4,911 or -1.1% over May 2005 levels. The total dollar value of FNS related benefits issued during June 2005 decreased by \$2,587,462 or -2.6% from \$98,245,457 reported in May 2005 to \$95,657,995 reported in June 2005. The average benefit issuance per person decreased by \$ 1.40 or -1.5% from those issued in May 2005. The average benefit issuance per person decreased from \$96.02 in May 2005 to \$94.62 in June 2005.



No of OWF Combined Assistance Groups During The Last 25 Months




No of OWF Combined Recipients During The Last 25 Months




DA Cash Assistance Groups




