

MONTHLY REVIEW OF PUBLIC ASSISTANCE STATISTICS FOR JULY 2002

OHIO WORKS FIRST

For the month of July 2002, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 85,250; recipients totaled 193,685 and money payments totaled \$25,842,618. The percent change from June 2002 to July 2002 was 1.5% for assistance groups; 1.8% for recipients, and 1.1% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 81,689 assistance groups; 178,945 recipients, and \$24,484,280 in money payments issued for July 2002. The percent change from June 2002 to July 2002 was 1.5% for assistance groups; 1.8% for recipients, and 1.2% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U) assistance groups totaled 3,561; recipients 14,740, and money payments were \$1,358,338. The percent change from June 2002 to July 2002 was 1.5% for assistance groups; 1.0% for recipients and 0.1% for money payments.

FOSTER CARE (TITLE IV-E)

A total of 24,305 children received \$13,340,679 in Title IV-E assistance during the month of July 2002. Included in this total were 7,453 foster care children who received \$7,118,319 in money payments. Of these Title IV-E children, 3,405 or 14.0% were in foster family homes who received \$1,266,223 and 4,048 or 16.7% children in child care institutions who received \$5,852,096 in OWF foster care assistance. The remaining 16,852 children reported as participating in Title IV-E received \$6,222,360 in adoption assistance. Overall, the average amount of Foster Care received per child was \$548.89.

DISABILITY ASSISTANCE (DA)

For the month of July 2002, there were 13,454 assistance groups; 13,828 recipients, and \$1,771,662 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$128.12. Total DA expenditures for medical services for July 2002 were an adjusted \$11,003,757. Of this total, \$6,827,264 or 62.0% was spent for prescribed drugs, and \$ 3,342,107 or 30.4% was spent for physician services. Medical expenses were paid for 21,538 recipients for the month of July 2002.


FNS BENEFITS:

Total persons participating in the FNS benefits program during July 2002 increased to 757,686 by 13,141 or 1.8% from 744,545 persons reported in June 2002. Households increased by 6,401 or 1.9% over June 2002 levels. The total dollar value of FNS related benefits issued during July 2002 increased by \$2,317,188 or 3.8% from \$60,688,791 reported in June 2002 to \$63,005,979 reported in July 2002. The average benefit issuance per person increased by \$1.65 or 2.0% from those issued in June 2002. The average benefit issuance per person increased from \$81.51 in June 2002 to \$83.16 in July 2002.



During the Last 25 Months




Number of OWF-Combined Recipients During the Last 25 Months




DA Cash Assistance Groups




Number of FNS Benefits Assist. Groups
