

MONTHLY REVIEW OF PUBLIC ASSISTANCE STATISTICS FOR JULY 2003

OHIO WORKS FIRST

For the month of July 2003, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 86,432; recipients totaled 193,223 and money payments totaled \$25,856,755. The percent change from June 2003 to July 2003 was 1.0% for assistance groups; 1.3% for recipients, and -0.3% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 82,562 assistance groups; 177,427 recipients, and \$24,375,298 in money payments issued for July 2003. The percent change from June 2003 to July 2003 was 0.9% for assistance groups; 1.1% for recipients, and -0.4% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U) assistance groups totaled 3,870; recipients 15,796, and money payments were \$1,481,457. The percent change from June 2003 to July 2003 was 3.1% for assistance groups; 2.9% for recipients and 0.4% for money payments.

FOSTER CARE (TITLE IV-E)

A total of 24,980 children received \$12,365,553 in Title IV-E assistance during the month of July 2003. Included in this total were 6,813 foster care children who received \$5,622,598 in money payments. Of these Title IV-E children, 3,120 or 12.5% were in foster family homes who received \$1,459,853 and 3,693 or 14.8% children in child care institutions who received \$4,162,745 in OWF foster care assistance. The remaining 18,167 children reported as participating in Title IV-E received \$6,742,955 in adoption assistance. Overall, the average amount of Foster Care received per child was \$495.02.

DISABILITY ASSISTANCE (DA)

For the month of July 2003, there were 16,314 assistance groups; 16,705 recipients, and \$1,921,319 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$115.01. Total DA expenditures for medical services for July 2003 were \$9,410,362. Of this total, \$6,295,993 or 66.9% was spent for prescribed drugs, and \$2,511,266 or 26.7% was spent for physician services. Medical expenses were paid for 22,599 recipients for an average expenditure of \$416.41 per recipient.


FNS BENEFITS:

Total persons participating in the FNS benefits program during July 2003 decreased to 884,678 by 2,460 or -0.3% from 887,138 persons reported in June 2003. Households decreased by 974 or -0.2% over June 2003 levels. The total dollar value of FNS related benefits issued during July 2003 decreased by \$170,474 or -0.2% from \$75,783,427 reported in June 2003 to \$75,612,953 reported in July 2003. The average benefit issuance per person increased by \$.05 or 0.1% from those issued in June 2003. The average benefit issuance per person increased from \$85.42 in June 2003 to \$85.47 in July 2003.



During the Last 25 Months




Number of OWF-Combined Recipients During the Last 25 Months




DA Cash Assistance Groups




Number of FNS Benefits Assist. Groups
