

# MONTHLY REVIEW OF PUBLIC ASSISTANCE STATISTICS FOR SEPTEMBER 2002

## OHIO WORKS FIRST

For the month of September 2002, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 84,535; recipients totaled 190,862 and money payments totaled \$25,585,347. The percent change from August 2002 to September 2002 was -0.5% for assistance groups; -0.8% for recipients, and -1.1% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 81,026 assistance groups; 176,457 recipients, and \$24,235,034 in money payments issued for September 2002. The percent change from August 2002 to September 2002 was -0.6% for assistance groups; -0.9% for recipients, and -1.1% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U) assistance groups totaled 3,509; recipients 14,405, and money payments were \$1,350,313. The percent change from August 2002 to September 2002 was 0.6% for assistance groups; 0.3% for recipients and -0.1% for money payments.

## FOSTER CARE (TITLE IV-E)

A total of 24,326 children received \$12,552,968 in Title IV-E assistance during the month of September 2002. Included in this total were 7,221 foster care children who received \$6,296,210 in money payments. Of these Title IV-E children, 3,294 or 13.5% were in foster family homes who received \$1,351,747 and 3,927 or 16.1% children in child care institutions who received \$4,944,463 in OWF foster care assistance. The remaining 17,105 children reported as participating in Title IV-E received \$6,256,758 in adoption assistance. Overall, the average amount of Foster Care received per child was \$516.03.

## DISABILITY ASSISTANCE (DA)

For the month of September 2002, there were 14,110 assistance groups; 14,518 recipients, and \$1,829,682 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$126.03. Total DA expenditures for medical services for September 2002 were \$6,343,091. Of this total, \$4,209,646 or 66.4% was spent for prescribed drugs, and \$1,728,569 or 27.3% was spent for physician services. Medical expenses were paid for 18,742 recipients for an average expenditure of \$338.44 per recipient.


## FNS BENEFITS:

Total persons participating in the FNS benefits program during September 2002 increased to 773,105 by 18,906 or 2.5% from 754,199 persons reported in August 2002. Households increased by 7,280 or 2.1% over August 2002 levels. The total dollar value of FNS related benefits issued during September 2002 increased by \$2,561,054 or 4.1% from \$61,893,895 reported in August 2002 to \$64,454,949 reported in September 2002. The average benefit issuance per person increased by \$1.30 or 1.6% from those issued in August 2002. The average benefit issuance per person increased from \$82.07 in August 2002 to \$83.37 in September 2002.



During the Last 25 Months




# Number of OWF-Combined Recipients During the Last 25 Months




# DA Cash Assistance Groups




# Number of FNS Benefits Assist. Groups
