

MONTHLY REVIEW OF PUBLIC ASSISTANCE STATISTICS FOR SEPTEMBER 2003

OHIO WORKS FIRST

For the month of September 2003, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 87,006; recipients totaled 194,482 and money payments totaled \$26,417,841. The percent change from August 2003 to September 2003 was 0.2% for assistance groups; 0.3% for recipients, and 0.0% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 83,155 assistance groups; 178,759 recipients, and \$24,897,155 in money payments issued for September 2003. The percent change from August 2003 to September 2003 was 0.1% for assistance groups; 0.1% for recipients, and -0.1% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U) assistance groups totaled 3,851; recipients 15,723, and money payments were \$1,520,686. The percent change from August 2003 to September 2003 was 1.3% for assistance groups; 1.7% for recipients and 2.3% for money payments.

FOSTER CARE (TITLE IV-E)

A total of 25,073 children received \$13,071,839 in Title IV-E assistance during the month of September 2003. Included in this total were 6,669 foster care children who received \$6,210,250 in money payments. Of these Title IV-E children, 3,207 or 12.8% were in foster family homes who received \$1,287,382 and 3,462 or 13.8% children in child care institutions who received \$4,922,869 in OWF foster care assistance. The remaining 18,404 children reported as participating in Title IV-E received \$6,861,589 in adoption assistance. Overall, the average amount of Foster Care received per child was \$521.35.

DISABILITY ASSISTANCE (DA)

For the month of September 2003, there were 13,250 assistance groups; 13,405 recipients, and \$1,598,862 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$119.27. Total DA expenditures for medical services for September 2003 were \$7,271,805. Of this total, \$5,100,447 or 70.1% was spent for prescribed drugs, and \$1,771,127 or 24.4% was spent for physician services. Medical expenses were paid for 19,600 recipients for an average expenditure of \$371.01 per recipient.

FNS BENEFITS:


Total persons participating in the FNS benefits program during September 2003 increased to 900,572 by 15,627 or 1.8% from 884,945 persons reported in August 2003. Households increased by 7,604 or 1.9% over August 2003 levels. The total dollar value of FNS related benefits issued during September 2003 increased by \$2,273,968 or 2.9% from \$77,279,906 reported in August 2003 to \$79,553,874 reported in September 2003. The average benefit issuance per person increased by \$1.01 or 1.2% from those issued in August 2003. The average benefit issuance per person increased from \$87.33 in August 2003 to \$88.34 in September 2003.

All data in the PAMS report is limited to the information available at the time it was constructed. It does not account for backdated or retroactive eligibility or any adjustments made subsequent to its creation.



During the Last 25 Months




Number of OWF-Combined Recipients During the Last 25 Months




DA Cash Assistance Groups




Number of FNS Benefits Assist. Groups
