MONTHLY REVIEW OF PUBLIC ASSISTANCE STATISTICS FOR NOVEMBER 2004

OHIO WORKS FIRST

For the month of November 2004, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 87,319; recipients totaled 193,500 and money payments totaled \$26,538,317. The percent change from October 2004 to November 2004 was -0.3% for assistance groups; -0.4% for recipients, and -1.0% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 83,310 assistance groups; 177,076 recipients, and \$24,934,252 in money payments issued for November 2004. The percent change from October 2004 to November 2004 was -0.2% for assistance groups; -0.3% for recipients, and -0.9% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U) assistance groups totaled 4,009; recipients, 16,424 and money payments were \$1,604,065. The percent change from October 2004 to November 2004 was -1.9% for assistance groups; -1.0% for recipients and -2.5% for money payments.

FOSTER CARE (TITLE IV-E)

A total of 27,029 children received \$14,560,414 in Title IV-E assistance during the month of November 2004. Included in this total were 7,437 foster care children who received \$6,986,544 in money payments. Of these Title IV-E children, 2,947 or 10.9% were in foster family homes who received \$1,298,734 and 4,490 or 16.6% children in child care institutions who received \$5,687,810 in OWF foster care assistance. The remaining 19,592 children reported as participating in Title IV-E received \$7,573,871 in adoption assistance. Overall, the average amount of Foster Care received per child was \$538.70.

DISABILITY ASSISTANCE (DA)

For the month of November 2004, there were 13,070 assistance groups; 13,173 recipients, and \$1,776,656 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$134.87. Total DA expenditures for medical services for November 2004 were \$ 7,051,210. Of this total, \$4,789,581 or 67.9% was spent for prescribed drugs, and \$1,799,003 or 25.5% was spent for physician services. Medical expenses were paid for 16,572 recipients for an average expenditure of \$425.49 per recipient.

FNS BENEFITS:


Total persons participating in the FNS benefits program during November 2004 increased to 983,171 by 8,301 or 0.9% from 974,870 persons reported in October 2004. Households increased by 2,035 or 0.5% over October 2004 levels. The total dollar value of FNS related benefits issued during November 2004 increased by \$1,371,973 or 1.5% from \$93,499,595 reported in October 2004 to \$94,871,568 reported in November 2004. The average benefit issuance per person increased by \$.59 or 0.6% from those issued in October 2004. The average benefit issuance per person increased from \$95.91 in October 2004 to \$96.50 in November 2004.

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

No of OWF Combined Assistance Groups During The Last 25 Month




No of OWF Combined Recipients During The Last 25 Months




DA Cash Assistance Groups




