## MONTHLY REVIEW OF PUBLIC ASSISTANCE STATISTICS FOR NOVEMBER 2005

### OHIO WORKS FIRST

For the month of November 2005, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 84,497; recipients totaled 184,637 and money payments totaled \$27,779,415. The percent change from October 2005 to November 2005 was 1.0% for assistance groups; 1.3% for recipients, and 2.8% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 80,521 assistance groups; 168,417 recipients, and \$26,036,089 in money payments issued for November 2005. The percent change from October 2005 to November 2005 was 0.9% for assistance groups; 1.1% for recipients, and 2.7% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U) assistance groups totaled 3,976; recipients, 16,220 and money payments were \$1,743,326. The percent change from October 2005 to November 2005 was 2.4% for assistance groups; 3.0% for recipients and 4.5% for money payments.

### FOSTER CARE (TITLE IV-E)

A total of 26,765 children received \$14,316,360 in Title IV-E assistance during the month of November 2005. Included in this total were 6,451 foster care children who received \$6,504,818 in money payments. Of these Title IV-E children, 2,836 or 10.6% were in foster family homes who received \$1,274,919 and 3,615 or 13.5% children in child care institutions who received \$5,229,900 in OWF foster care assistance. The remaining 20,314 children reported as participating in Title IV-E received \$7,811,541 in adoption assistance. Overall, the average amount of Foster Care received per child was \$534.89.

### DISABILITY ASSISTANCE (DA)

For the month of November 2005, there were 12,309 assistance groups; 12,393 recipients, and \$1,566,804 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$126.43. Total DA expenditures for medical services for November 2005 were \$ 4,756,042. Of this total, \$2,480,848 or 70.3% was spent for prescribed drugs, and \$ 780,526 or 22.1% was spent for physician services. Medical expenses were paid for 8,399 recipients for an average expenditure of \$566.26 per recipient.

### FNS BENEFITS:

Total persons participating in the FNS benefits program during November 2005 increased to 1,041,403 by 289 or 0.0% from 1,041,114 persons reported in October 2005. Households increased by 262 or 0.1% over October 2005 levels. The total dollar value of FNS related benefits issued during November 2005 decreased by \$ 858,860 or -0.8% from \$104,447,942 reported in October 2005 to \$103,589,082 reported in November 2005. The average benefit issuance per person decreased by \$.85 or -0.8% from those issued in October 2005. The average benefit issuance per person decreased from \$100.32 in October 2005 to \$99.47 in November 2005.


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

# No of OWF Combined Assistance Groups During The Last 25 Months




# No of OWF Combined Recipients During The Last 25 Months




# DA Cash Assistance Groups




