

MONTHLY REVIEW OF PUBLIC ASSISTANCE STATISTICS FOR NOVEMBER 2003

OHIO WORKS FIRST

For the month of November 2003, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 85,999; recipients totaled 191,655 and money payments totaled \$26,034,918. The percent change from October 2003 to November 2003 was -1.9% for assistance groups; -2.3% for recipients, and -2.6% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 82,275 assistance groups; 176,454 recipients, and \$24,577,620 in money payments issued for November 2003. The percent change from October 2003 to November 2003 was -1.9% for assistance groups; -2.2% for recipients, and -2.5% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U) assistance groups totaled 3,724; recipients, 15,201, and money payments were \$1,457,298. The percent change from October 2003 to November 2003 was -2.9% for assistance groups; -2.8% for recipients and -4.8% for money payments.

FOSTER CARE (TITLE IV-E)

A total of 25,730 children received \$13,152,735 in Title IV-E assistance during the month of November 2003. Included in this total were 7,102 foster care children who received \$6,207,894 in money payments. Of these Title IV-E children, 3,295 or 12.8% were in foster family homes who received \$1,321,449 and 3,807 or 14.8% children in child care institutions who received \$4,886,446 in OWF foster care assistance. The remaining 18,628 children reported as participating in Title IV-E received \$6,944,841 in adoption assistance. Overall, the average amount of Foster Care received per child was \$511.18.

DISABILITY ASSISTANCE (DA)

For the month of November 2003, there were 12,858 assistance groups; 12,995 recipients, and \$1,619,377 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$124.62. Total DA expenditures for medical services for November 2003 were \$6,479,796. Of this total, \$4,460,985 or 68.8% was spent for prescribed drugs, and \$1,653,265 or 25.5% was spent for physician services. Medical expenses were paid for 17,437 recipients for an average expenditure of \$371.61 per recipient.

FNS BENEFITS:


Total persons participating in the FNS benefits program during November 2003 increased to 901,990 by 162 or 0.0% from 901,828 persons reported in October 2003. Households decreased by 1,854 or -0.5% over October 2003 levels. The total dollar value of FNS related benefits issued during November 2003 decreased by \$1,111,131 or -1.4% from \$80,400,808 reported in October 2003 to \$79,289,677 reported in November 2003. The average benefit issuance per person decreased by \$1.24 or -1.4% from those issued in October 2003. The average benefit issuance per person decreased from \$89.15 in October 2003 to \$87.91 in November 2003.

Please note: All data in the PAMS report is limited to the information available at the time it was constructed. It does not account for backdated or retroactive eligibility or any adjustments made subsequent to its creation.



During the Last 25 Months




Number of OWF-Combined Recipients During the Last 25 Months




DA Cash Assistance Groups




Number of FNS Benefits Assist. Groups
