Monthly Review of Public Assistance Statistics for May 2008

Ohio Works First (OWF)

For the month of May 2008, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 79,784; recipients totaled 172,189 and money payments totaled \$26,800,808. The percent change from April 2008 to May 2008 was -0.7% for assistance groups; -0.8% for recipients, and -1.8% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 76,124 assistance groups; 157,610 recipients, and \$25,163,824 in money payments issued for May 2008. The percent change from April 2008 to May 2008 was -0.7% for assistance groups; -0.8% for recipients, and -1.8% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U), assistance groups totaled 3,660, recipients, 14,579 and money payments were \$1,636,984. The percent change from April 2008 to May 2008 was -0.9% for assistance groups; -0.7% for recipients and -2.2% for money payments.

Foster Care (TITLE IV-E)

Disability Assistance (DA)

For the month of May 2008, there were 17,433 assistance groups; 17,529 recipients, and \$2,572,450 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$146.75. Total DA expenditures for medical services for May 2008 were \$1,010,778. Of this total, \$750,164 or 74.2% was spent for prescribed drugs, and \$187,205 or 18.5% was spent for physician services. Medical expenses were paid for 2,137 recipients for an average expenditure of \$472.99 per recipient.

Food And Nutrition Services Benefits (FNS) (Food Stamps)


Total persons participating in the FNS benefits program during May 2008 increased to 1,159,837 by 7,868 or 0.7% from 1,151,969 persons reported in April 2008. Households increased by 3,890 or 0.7% over April 2008 levels. The total dollar value of FNS related benefits issued during May 2008 increased by \$ 135,239 or 0.1% from \$123,206,567 reported in April 2008 to \$123,341,806 reported in May 2008. The average benefit issuance per person decreased by \$ 0.61 or -0.6% from those issued in April 2008. The average benefit issuance per person decreased from \$106.95 reported in April 2008 to \$106.34 reported in May 2008.

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

No of OWF Combined Net Expenditure During The Last 25 Months





DA Cash Recipients During The Last 25 Months





Food Stamp Benefits Cash Recipients During The Last 25 Months


