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Monthly Review of Public Assistance Statistics for April 2009

Ohio Works First (OWF)

For the month of April 2009, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 88,369; recipients totaled 196,830 and money payments totaled \$31,987,540. The percent change from March 2009 to April 2009 was 0.4% for assistance groups; 0.5% for recipients, and -0.1% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 82,304 assistance groups; 172,915 recipients, and \$29,066,599 in money payments issued for April 2009. The percent change from March 2009 to April 2009 was 0.3% for assistance groups; 0.5% for recipients, and -0.1% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U), assistance groups totaled 6,065, recipients, 23,915 and money payments were \$2,920,941. The percent change from March 2009 to April 2009 was 1.3% for assistance groups; 0.8% for recipients and 0.4% for money payments.

Foster Care (TITLE IV-E)

Disability Assistance (DA)

For the month of April 2009, there were 15,837 assistance groups; 15,913 recipients, and \$2,075,640 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$130.44. Total DA expenditures for medical services for April 2009 were \$918,276. Of this total, \$678,156 or 73.9% was spent for prescribed drugs, and \$180,136 or 19.6% was spent for physician services. Medical expenses were paid for 1,452 recipients for an average expenditure of \$632.42 per recipient.

Food And Nutrition Services Benefits (FNS) (Food Stamps)

Total persons participating in the FNS benefits program during April 2009 increased to 1,366,929 by 24,102 or 1.8% from 1,342,827 persons reported in March 2009. Households increased by 11,939 or 1.9% over March 2009 levels. The total dollar value of FNS related benefits issued during April 2009 increased by \$27,045,374 or 16.2% from \$166,620,543 reported in March 2009 to \$193,665,917 reported in April 2009. The average benefit issuance per person increased by \$17.60 or 14.2% from those issued in March 2009. The average benefit issuance per person increased from \$124.08 reported in March 2009 to \$141.68 reported in April 2009.

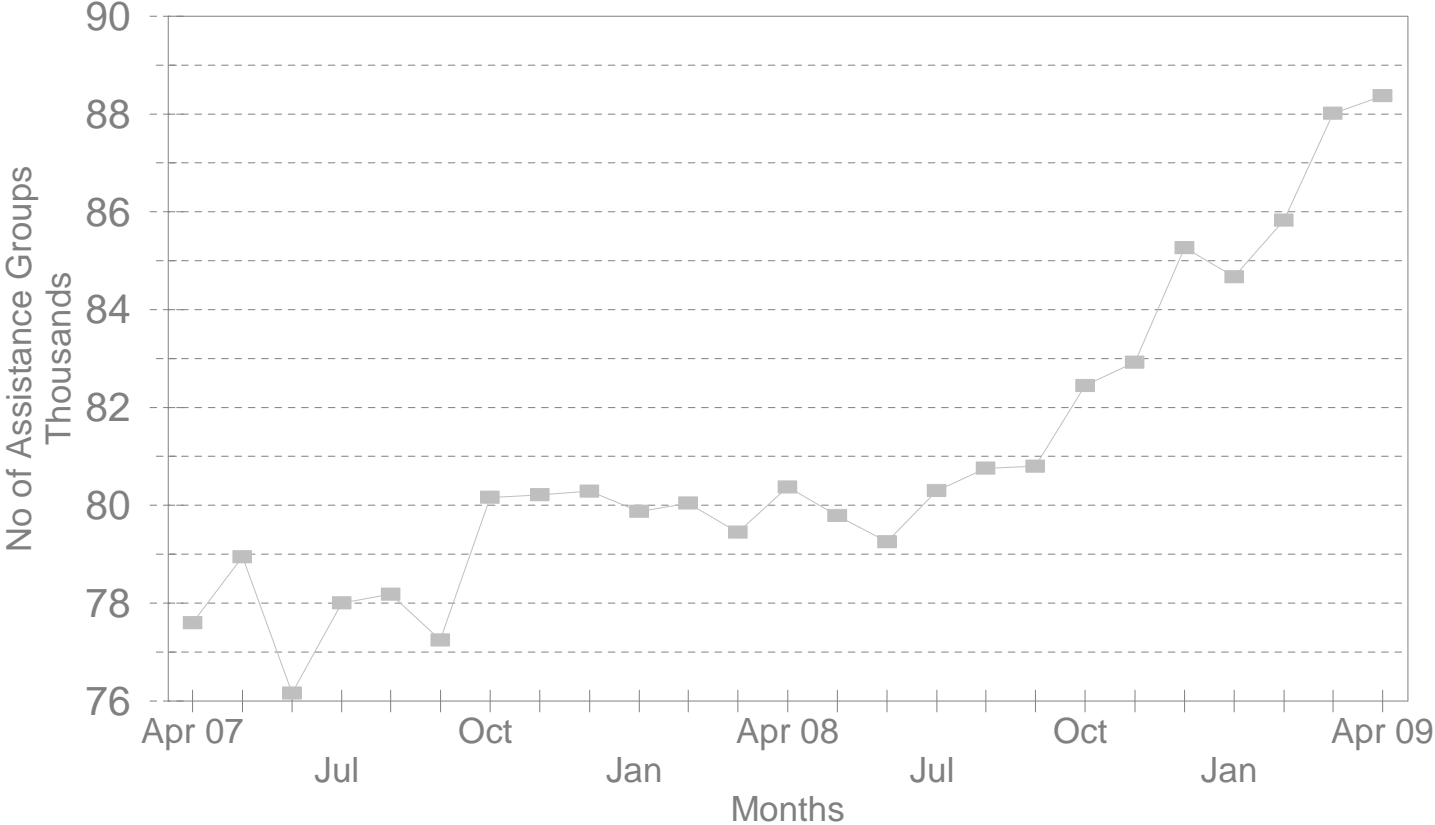

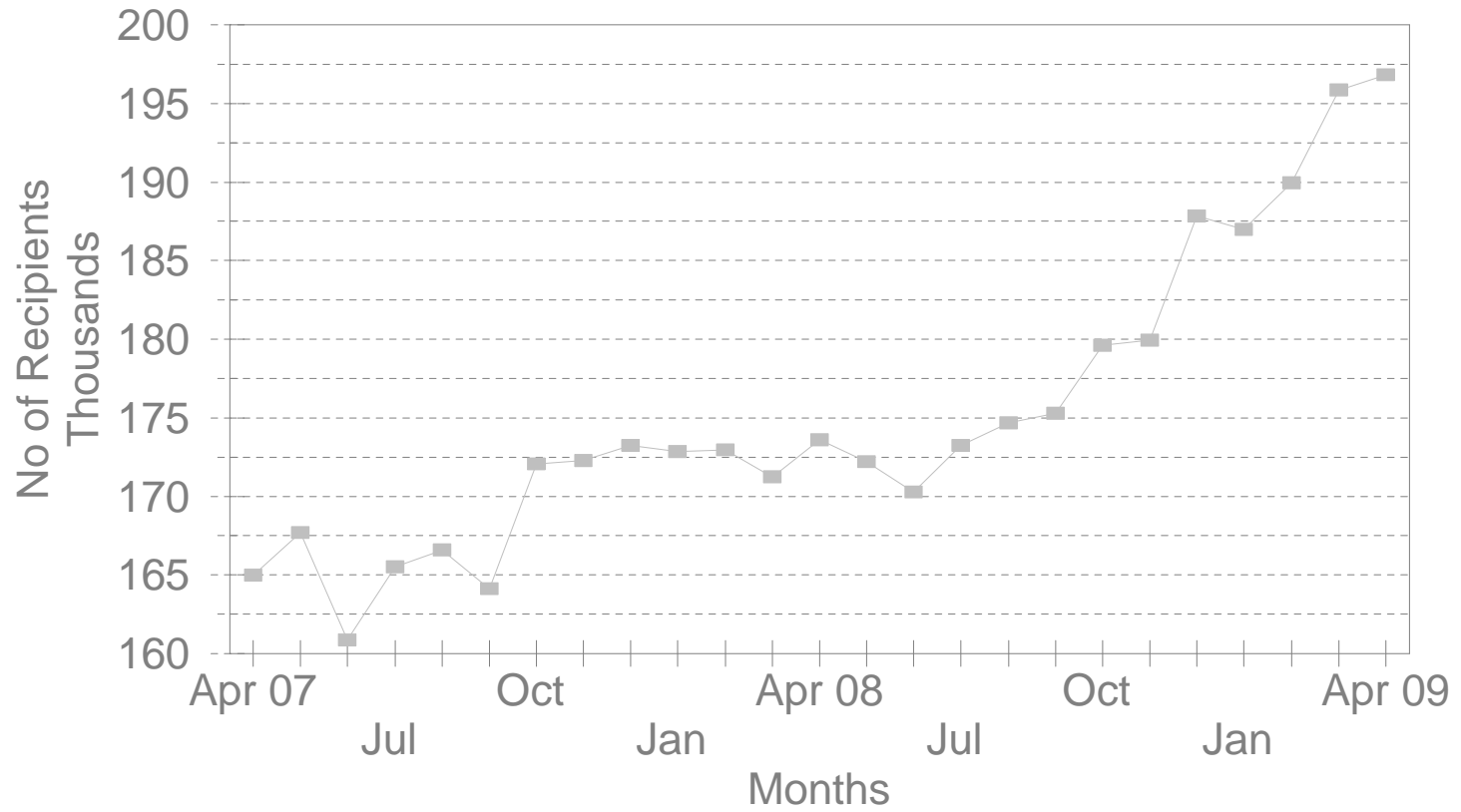

No of OWF Combined Assistance Groups

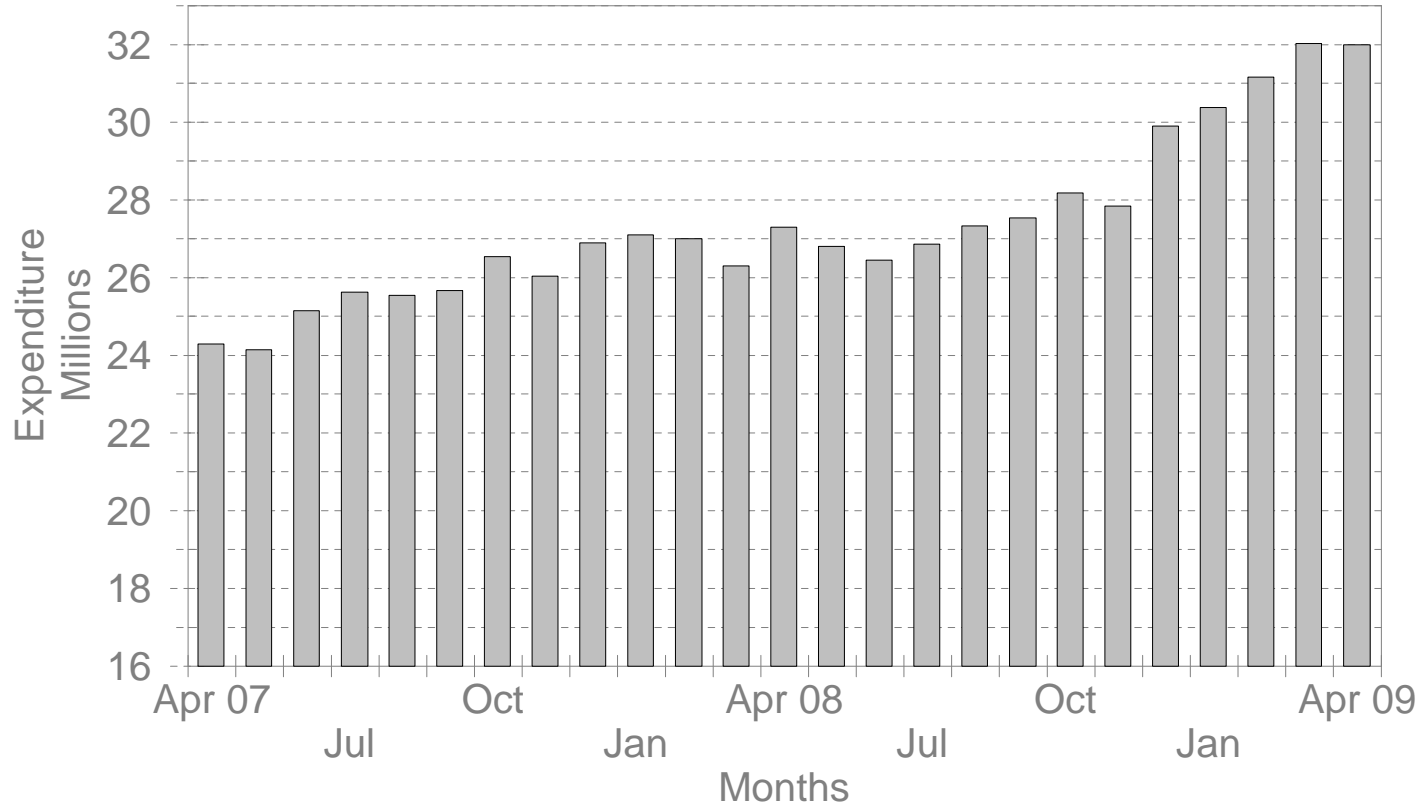
During The Last 25 months

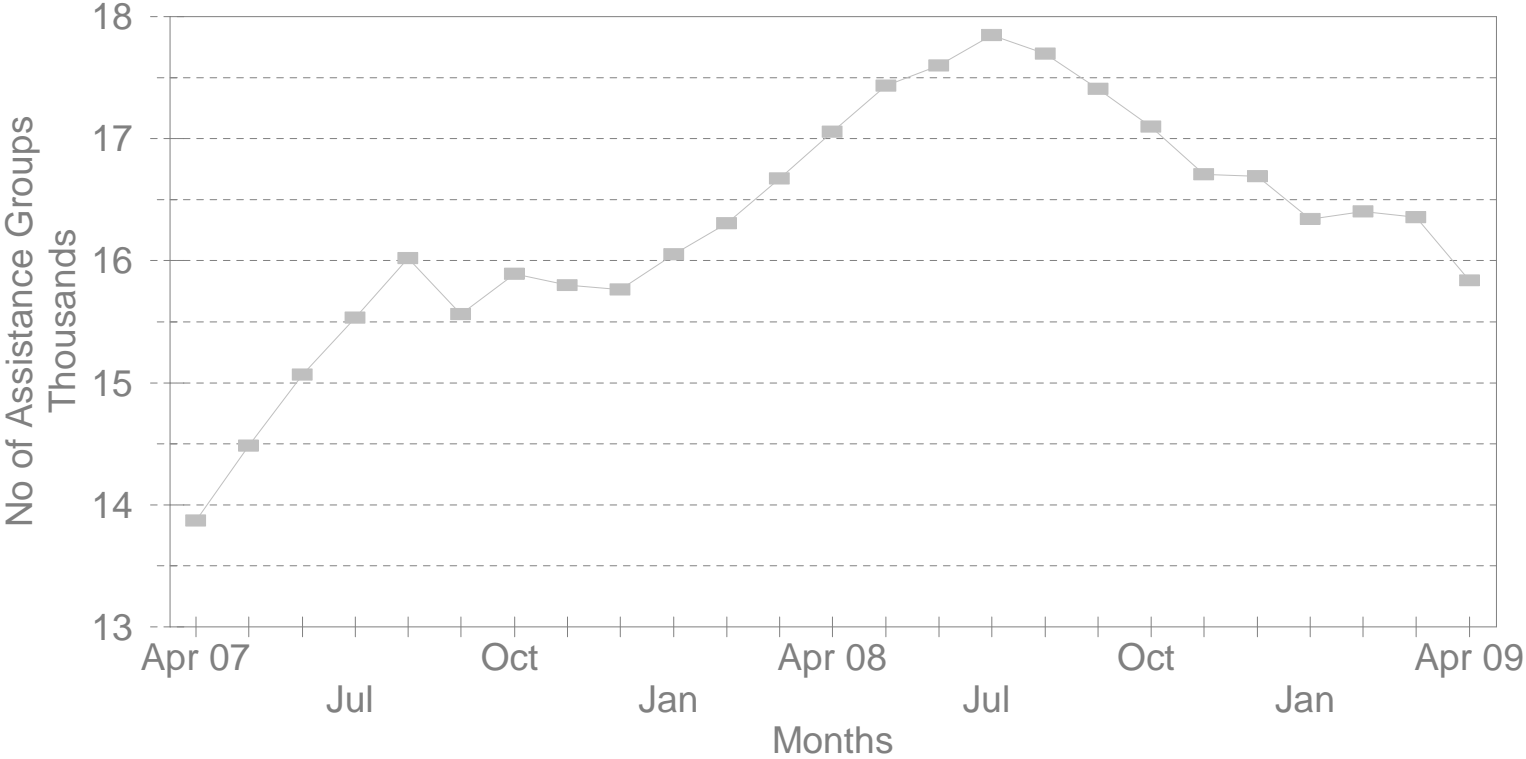

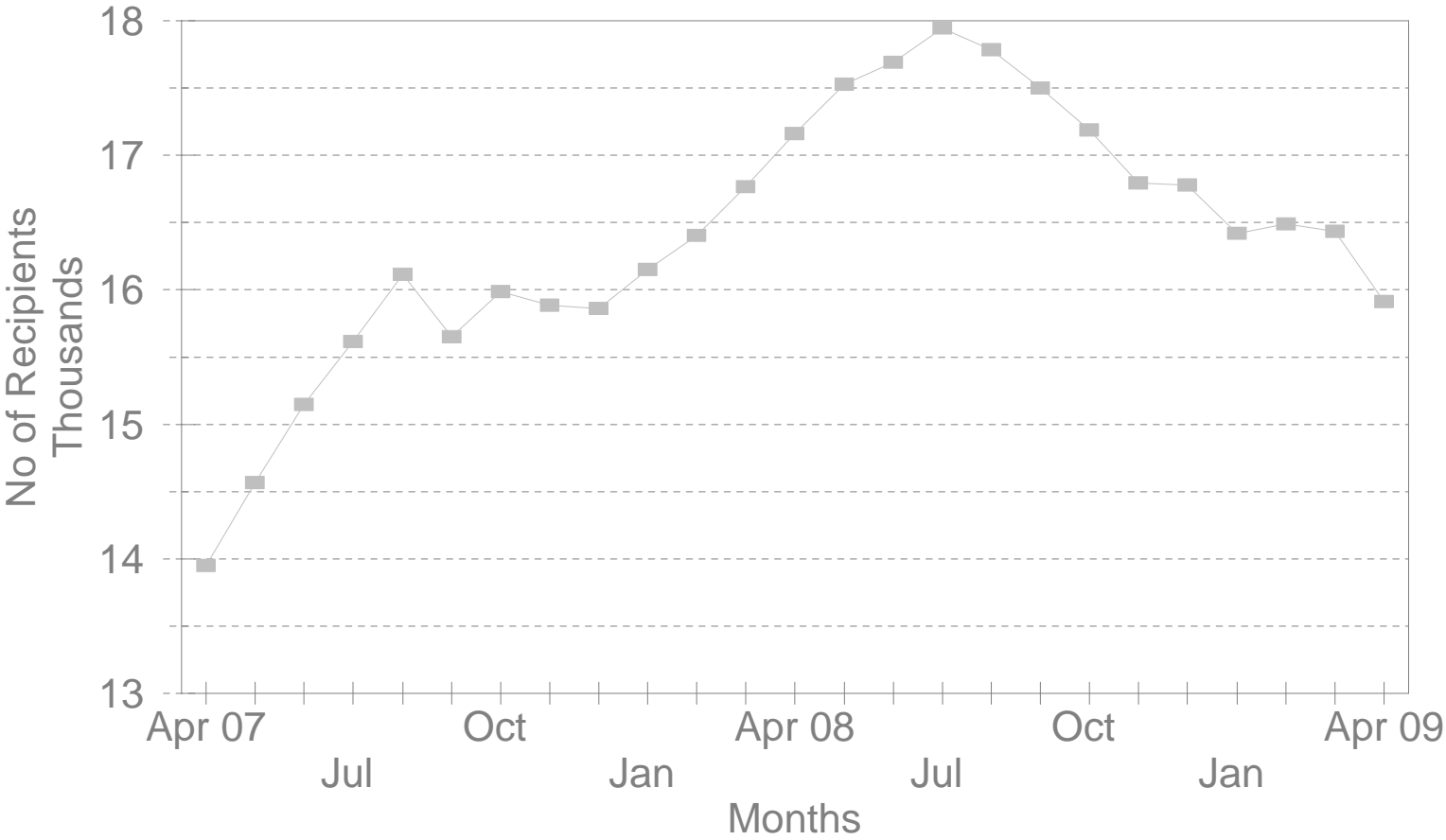

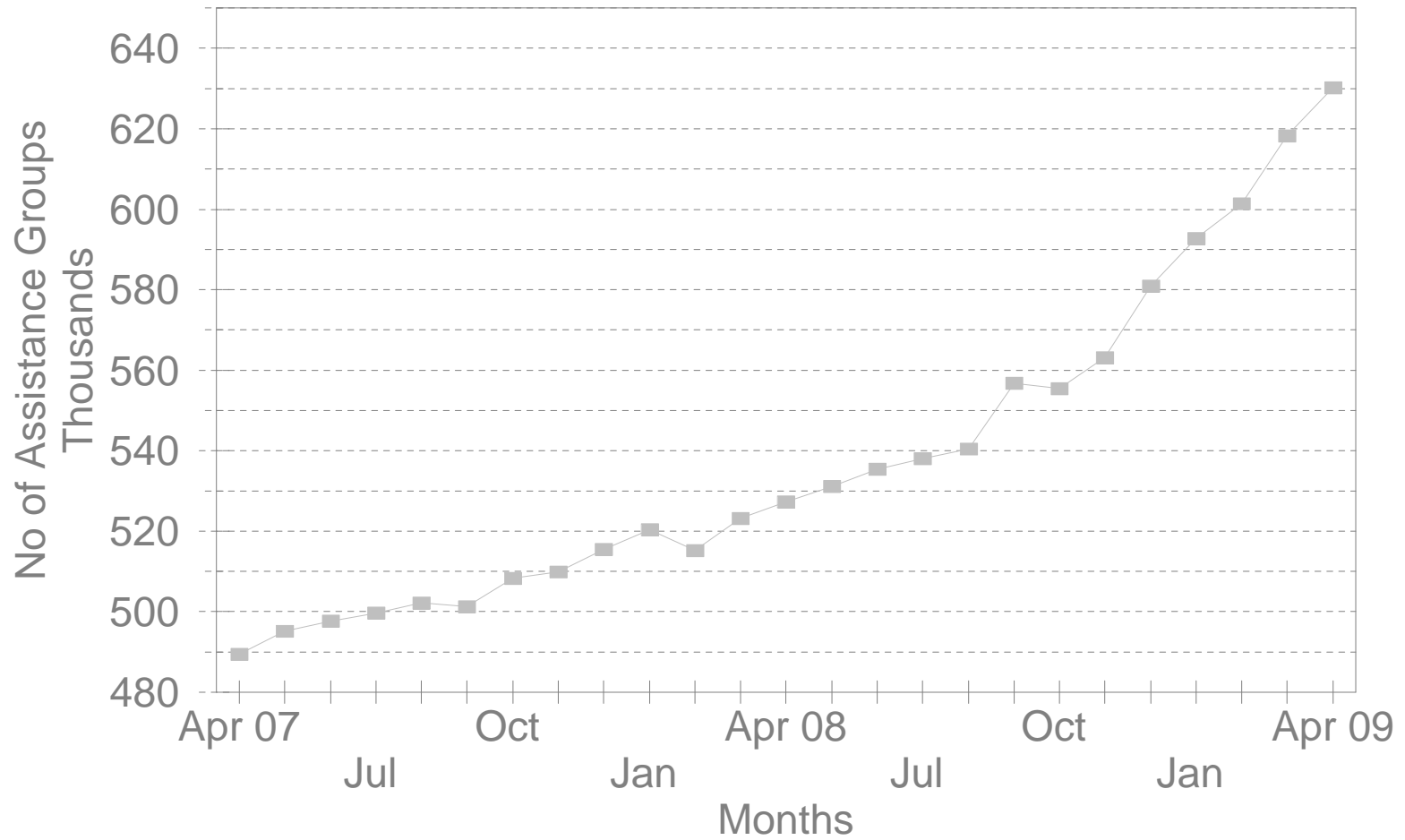

During Last 25 Months

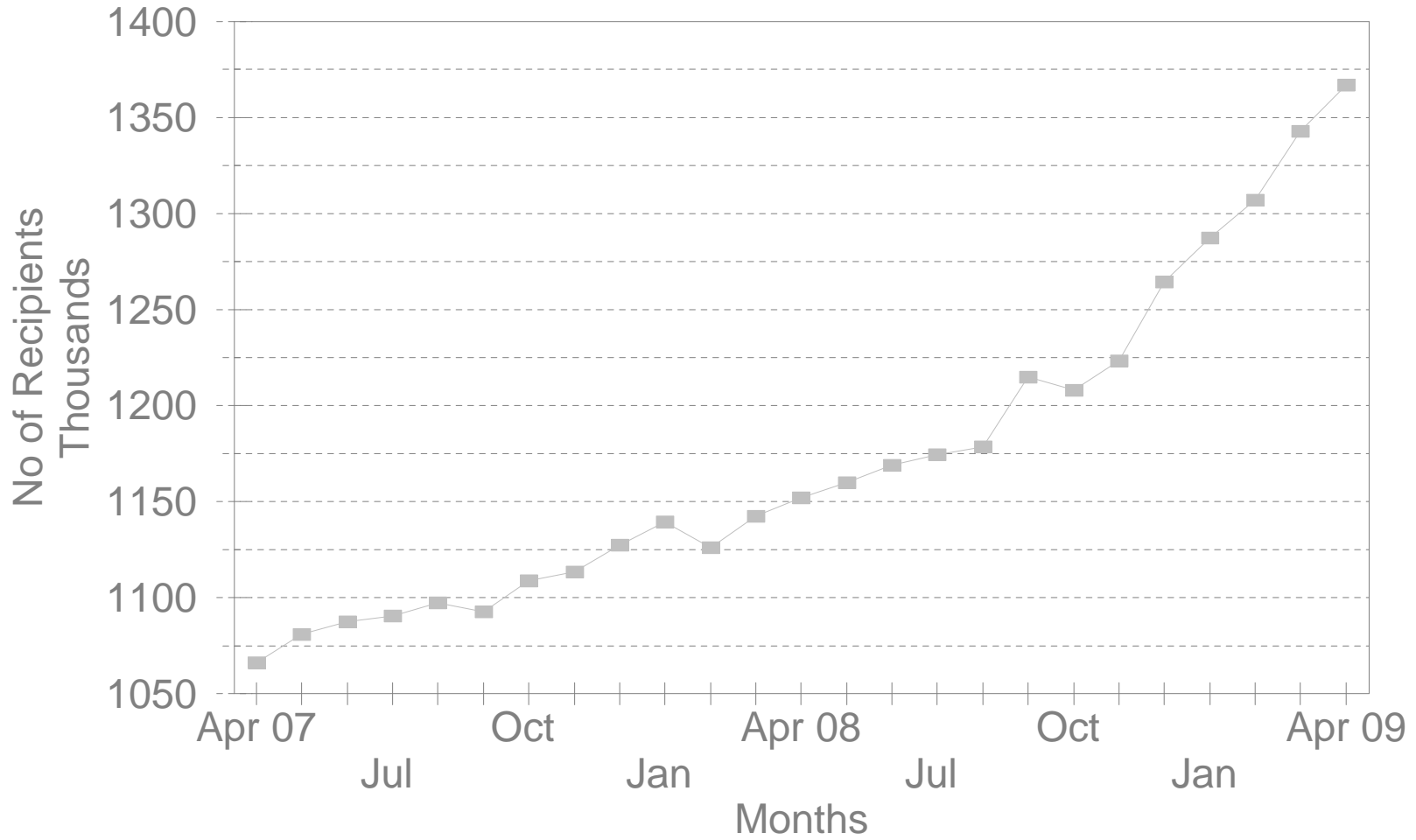
