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Monthly Review of Public Assistance Statistics for May 2009

Ohio Works First (OWF)

For the month of May 2009, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 90,968; recipients totaled 204,141 and money payments totaled \$33,370,579. The percent change from April 2009 to May 2009 was 2.9% for assistance groups; 3.7% for recipients, and 4.3% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 84,606 assistance groups; 179,133 recipients, and \$30,325,799 in money payments issued for May 2009. The percent change from April 2009 to May 2009 was 2.8% for assistance groups; 3.6% for recipients, and 4.3% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U), assistance groups totaled 6,362, recipients, 25,008 and money payments were \$3,044,780. The percent change from April 2009 to May 2009 was 4.9% for assistance groups; 4.6% for recipients and 4.2% for money payments.

Foster Care (TITLE IV-E)

Disability Assistance (DA)

For the month of May 2009, there were 15,620 assistance groups; 15,693 recipients, and \$2,073,551 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$132.13. Total DA expenditures for medical services for May 2009 were \$679,188. Of this total, \$515,229 or 75.9% was spent for prescribed drugs, and \$124,585 or 18.3% was spent for physician services. Medical expenses were paid for 1,374 recipients for an average expenditure of \$494.31 per recipient.

Food And Nutrition Services Benefits (FNS) (Food Stamps)


Total persons participating in the FNS benefits program during May 2009 increased to 1,401,563 by 34,634 or 2.5% from 1,366,929 persons reported in April 2009. Households increased by 14,802 or 2.3% over April 2009 levels. The total dollar value of FNS related benefits issued during May 2009 increased by \$5,640,751 or 2.9% from \$193,665,917 reported in April 2009 to \$199,306,668 reported in May 2009. The average benefit issuance per person increased by \$ 0.52 or 0.4% from those issued in April 2009. The average benefit issuance per person increased from \$141.68 reported in April 2009 to \$142.20 reported in May 2009.

Please note: All data in the PAMS report is limited to the information available at the time it was constructed. It does not account for backdated or retroactive eligibility or any adjustments made subsequent to its creation.




No of OWF Combined Assistance Groups During The Last 25 months






Food Stamp Benefits Assistance Groups
