## Monthly Review of Public Assistance Statistics for August 2009

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### Ohio Works First (OWF)

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For the month of August 2009, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 95,406; recipients totaled 216,733 and money payments totaled \$34,849,251. The percent change from July 2009 to August 2009 was 1.0% for assistance groups; 1.2% for recipients, and 0.9% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 88,423 assistance groups; 189,232 recipients, and \$31,508,567 in money payments issued for August 2009. The percent change from July 2009 to August 2009 was 0.9% for assistance groups; 1.0% for recipients, and 0.7% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U), assistance groups totaled 6,983, recipients, 27,501 and money payments were \$3,340,684. The percent change from July 2009 to August 2009 was 2.5% for assistance groups; 2.7% for recipients and 2.5% for money payments.

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### Foster Care (TITLE IV-E)

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### Disability Assistance (DA)

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For the month of August 2009, there were 14,722 assistance groups; 14,783 recipients, and \$1,930,359 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$130.58. Total DA expenditures for medical services for August 2009 were \$640,172. Of this total, \$458,498 or 71.6% was spent for prescribed drugs, and \$118,824 or 18.6% was spent for physician services. Medical expenses were paid for 1,254 recipients for an average expenditure of \$510.50 per recipient.

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### Food And Nutrition Services Benefits (FNS) (Food Stamps)

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Total persons participating in the FNS benefits program during August 2009 increased to 1,480,927 by 24,782 or 1.7% from 1,456,145 persons reported in July 2009. Households increased by 11,977 or 1.8% over July 2009 levels. The total dollar value of FNS related benefits issued during August 2009 increased by \$4,457,281 or 2.2% from \$205,409,386 reported in July 2009 to \$209,866,667 reported in August 2009. The average benefit issuance person increased by \$0.65 or 0.5% from those issued in July 2009. The average benefit issuance per person increased from \$141.06 reported in July 2009 to \$141.71 reported in August 2009.






## No of OWF Combined Assistance Groups During The Last 25 months




# Food Stamp Benefits Assistance Groups
