Monthly Review of Public Assistance Statistics for January 2010

Ohio Works First (OWF)

For the month of January 2010, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 99,346; recipients totaled 228,030 and money payments totaled \$37,133,133. The percent change from December 2009 to January 2010 was -3.1% for assistance groups; -3.5% for recipients, and -2.6% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 91,267 assistance groups; 196,216 recipients, and \$33,125,548 in money payments issued for January 2010. The percent change from December 2009 to January 2010 was -3.0% for assistance groups; -3.6% for recipients, and -2.8% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U), assistance groups totaled 8,079, recipients, 31,814 and money payments were \$4,007,585. The percent change from December 2009 to January 2010 was -3.3% for assistance groups; -3.2% for recipients and -0.4% for money payments.

Foster Care (TITLE IV-E)

Disability Assistance (DA)

For the month of January 2010, there were 13,751 assistance groups; 13,813 recipients, and \$1,944,892 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$140.80. Total DA expenditures for medical services for January 2010 were \$9,997. Of this total, -\$1,745 or -17.5% was spent for prescribed drugs, and \$8,099 or 81.0% was spent for physician services. Medical expenses were paid for 134 recipients for an average expenditure of \$74.60 per recipient.

Food And Nutrition Services Benefits (FNS) (Food Stamps)

Total persons participating in the FNS benefits program during January 2010 increased to 1,579,716 by 3,357 or 0.2% from 1,576,359 persons reported in December 2009. Households increased by 3,118 or 0.4% over December 2009 levels. The total dollar value of FNS related benefits issued during January 2010 increased by \$329,267 or 0.1% from \$223,793,418 reported in December 2009 to \$224,122,685 reported in January 2010. The average benefit issuance person decreased by \$0.09 or - 0.1% from those issued in December 2009. The average benefit issuance per person decreased from \$141.97 reported in December 2009 to \$141.88 reported in January 2010.





No of OWF Combined Assistance Groups


During The Last 25 months







During Last 25 Months


