Monthly Review of Public Assistance Statistics for June 2010

Ohio Works First (OWF)

For the month of June 2010, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 105,098; recipients totaled 241,669 and money payments totaled \$47,032,882. The percent change from May 2010 to June 2010 was 6.3% for assistance groups; 7.1% for recipients, and 27.1% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 96,490 assistance groups; 208,023 recipients, and \$42,390,451 in money payments issued for June 2010. The percent change from May 2010 to June 2010 was 6.3% for assistance groups; 7.1% for recipients, and 28.2% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U), assistance groups totaled 8,608, recipients, 33,646 and money payments were \$4,642,431. The percent change from May 2010 to June 2010 was 6.8% for assistance groups; 7.3% for recipients and 17.5% for money payments.

Foster Care (TITLE IV-E)

Data not available due to SACWIS implementation.

Disability Assistance (DA)

For the month of June 2010, there were 13,286 assistance groups; 13,343 recipients, and \$1,994,734 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$149.50. Total DA expenditures for medical services for June 2010 were -\$114. Medical expenses were paid for 21 recipients.

Food And Nutrition Services Benefits (FNS) (Food Stamps)

Total persons participating in the FNS benefits program during June 2010 increased to 1,646,079 by 26,087 or 1.6% from 1,619,992 persons reported in May 2010. Households increased by 12,666 or 1.7% over May 2010 levels. The total dollar value of FNS related benefits issued during June 2010 increased by \$5,383,864 or 2.4% from \$228,848,672 reported in May 2010 to \$234,232,536 reported in June 2010. The average benefit issuance person increased by \$1.03 or 0.7% from those issued in May 2010. The average benefit issuance per person increased from \$141.27 reported in May 2010 to \$142.30 reported in June 2010.





During The Last 25 months




No of OWF Combined Recipients During The Last 25 Months








Food Stamp Benefits Assistance Groups
