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Monthly Review of Public Assistance Statistics for November 2010

Ohio Works First (OWF)

For the month of November 2010, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 100,881; recipients totaled 231,242 and money payments totaled \$37,851,556. The percent change from October 2010 to November 2010 was 0.1% for assistance groups; 0.004% for recipients, and - 0.5% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 92,861 assistance groups; 199,614 recipients, and \$33,912,869 in money payments issued for November 2010. The percent change from October 2010 to November 2010 was 0.2% for assistance groups; 0.05% for recipients, and -0.4% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U), assistance groups totaled 8,020, recipients totaled 31,628 and money payments were \$3,938,687. The percent change from October 2010 to November 2010 was -0.4% for assistance groups; -0.3% for recipients and -1.1% for money payments.

Foster Care (TITLE IV-E)

Disability Assistance (DA)

For the month of November 2010, there were 13,231 assistance groups; 13,270 recipients, and \$2,004,082 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$151.02. Total DA expenditures for medical services for November 2010 were \$176. Medical expenses were charged for 5 recipients.

Food And Nutrition Services Benefits (FNS) (Food Stamps)

Total persons participating in the FNS benefits program during November 2010 increased to 1,772,304 by 61,668 or 3.6% from 1,710,636 persons reported in October 2010. Households increased by 27,254 or 3.4% over October 2010 levels. The total dollar value of FNS related benefits issued during November 2010 increased by \$7,343,058 or 3.1% from \$237,357,824 reported in October 2010 to \$244,700,882 reported in November 2010. The average benefit issuance per person decreased by \$0.68 or -0.5% from those issued in October 2010. The average benefit issuance per person decreased from \$138.75 reported in October 2010 to \$138.07 reported in November 2010.





Number of OWF Combined Assistance Groups


During The Last 25 months






