## Monthly Review of Public Assistance Statistics for December 2010

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### Ohio Works First (OWF)

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For the month of December 2010, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 101,077; recipients totaled 231,810 and money payments totaled \$38,216,077. The percent change from November 2010 to December 2010 was 0.2% for assistance groups; 0.2% for recipients, and 1.0% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 92,949 assistance groups; 199,839 recipients, and \$34,185,714 in money payments issued for December 2010. The percent change from November 2010 to December 2010 was 0.1% for assistance groups; 0.1% for recipients, and 0.8% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U), assistance groups totaled 8,128, recipients totaled 31,971 and money payments were \$4,030,363. The percent change from November 2010 to December 2010 was 1.3% for assistance groups; 1.1% for recipients and 2.3% for money payments.

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### Foster Care (TITLE IV-E)

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Data not available due to SACWIS implementation.

### Disability Assistance (DA)

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For the month of December 2010, there were 13,213 assistance groups; 13,247 recipients, and \$1,979,824 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$149.45. Total DA expenditures for medical services for December 2010 were \$-61.55. Medical expenses were charged for only 2 recipients.

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### Food And Nutrition Services Benefits (FNS) (Food Stamps)

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Total persons participating in the FNS benefits program during December 2010 increased to 1,795,207 by 22,903 or 1.3% from 1,772,304 persons reported in November 2010. Households increased by 12,406 or 1.5% over November 2010 levels. The total dollar value of FNS related benefits issued during December 2010 increased by \$351,531 or 1.4% from \$244,700,882 reported in November 2010 to \$248,218,413 reported in December 2010. The average benefit issuance per person increased by \$0.20 or 0.1% from those issued in November 2010. The average benefit issuance per person increased from \$138.07 reported in November 2010 to \$138.27 reported in December 2010.

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



# Number of OWF Combined Assistance Groups


## During The Last 25 months








