## Monthly Review of Public Assistance Statistics for March 2011

---

### Ohio Works First (OWF)

---

For the month of March 2011, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 97,497; recipients totaled 220,437 and money payments totaled \$36,148,606. The percent change from February 2011 to March 2011 was -0.01% for assistance groups; -0.2% for recipients, and -0.4% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 89,629 assistance groups; 189,794 recipients, and \$32,355,975 in money payments issued for March 2011. The percent change from February 2011 to March 2011 was -0.1% for assistance groups; -0.4% for recipients, and -0.4% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U), assistance groups totaled 7,868, recipients totaled 30,643 and money payments were \$3,792,631. The percent change from February 2011 to March 2011 was 1.0% for assistance groups; 0.5% for recipients and -0.2% for money payments.

### Disability Assistance (DA)

---

For the month of March 2011, there were 13,536 assistance groups; 13,575 recipients, and \$2,024,706 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$149.15. Total DA expenditures for medical services for March 2011 were -\$3,216. Medical expenses were charged for 10 recipients.

### Food And Nutrition Services Benefits (FNS) (Food Stamps)

---

Total persons participating in the FNS benefits program during March 2011 increased to 1,829,671 by 22,863 or 1.3% from 1,806,808 persons reported in February 2011. Households increased by 12,020 or 1.4% over February 2011 levels. The total dollar value of FNS related benefits issued during March 2011 increased by \$4,110,266 or 1.6% from \$250,965,419 reported in February 2011 to \$255,075,685 reported in March 2011. The average benefit issuance per person increased by \$0.51 or 0.4% from those issued in February 2011. The average benefit issuance per person increased from \$138.90 reported in February 2011 to \$139.41 reported in March 2011.

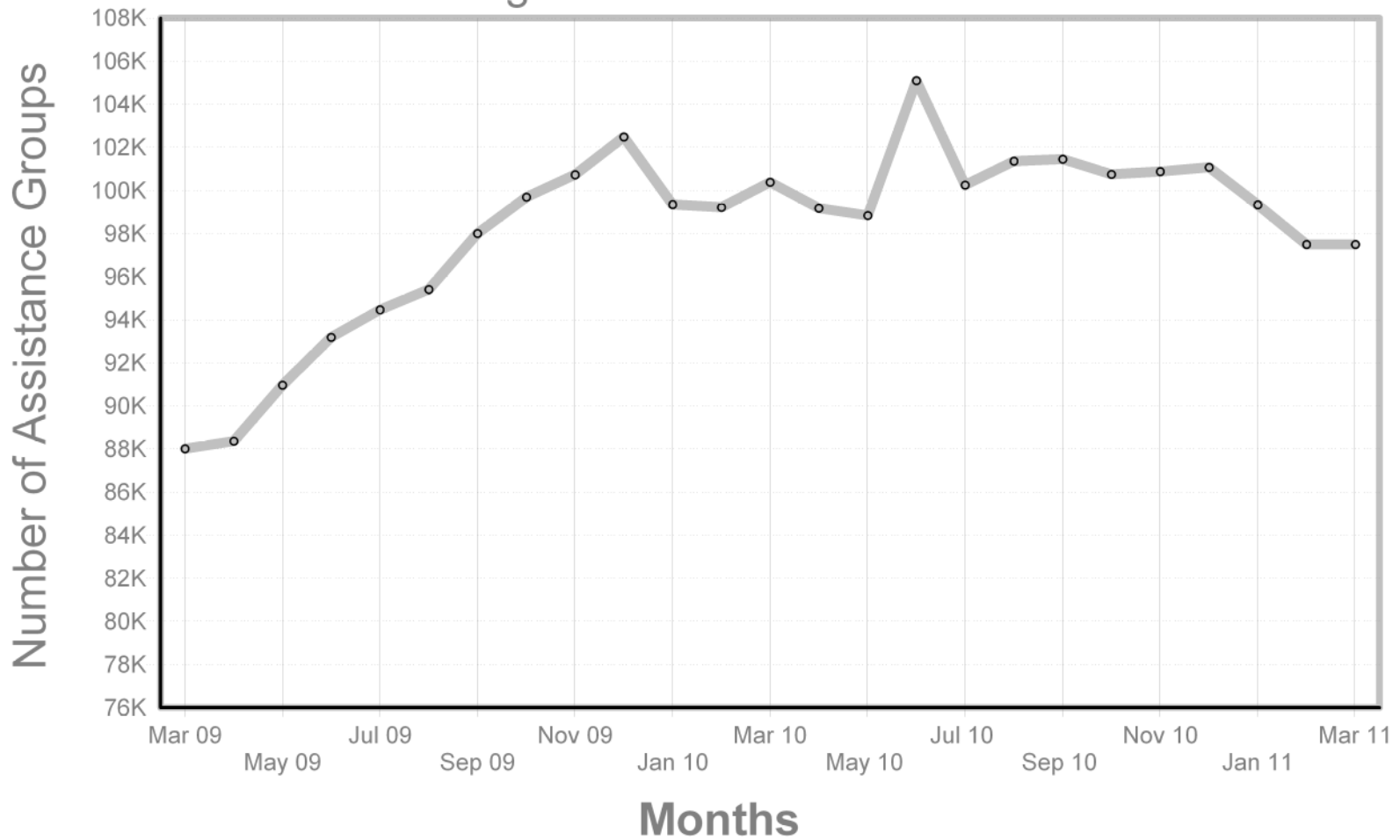

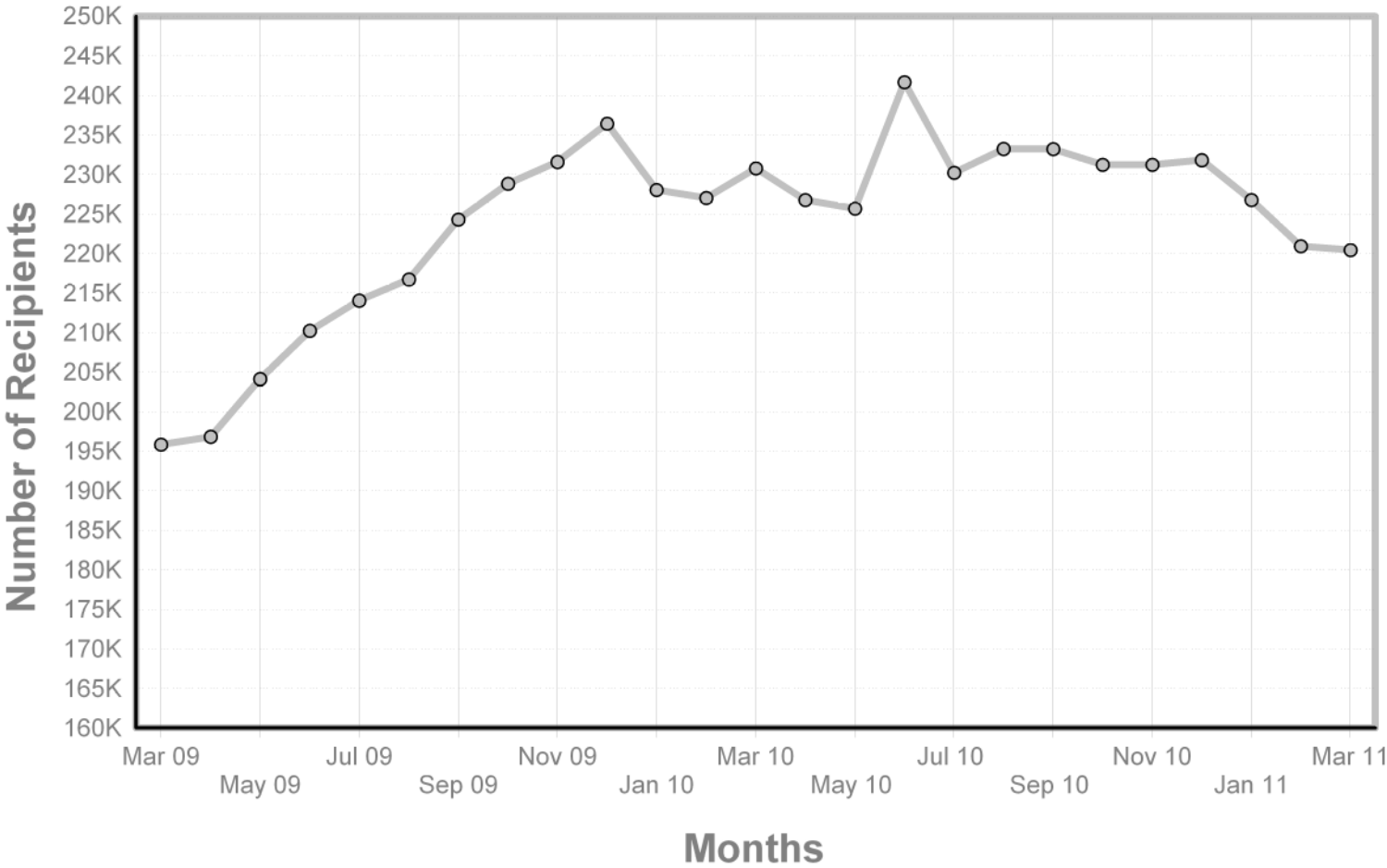

# Number of OWF Combined Assistance Groups

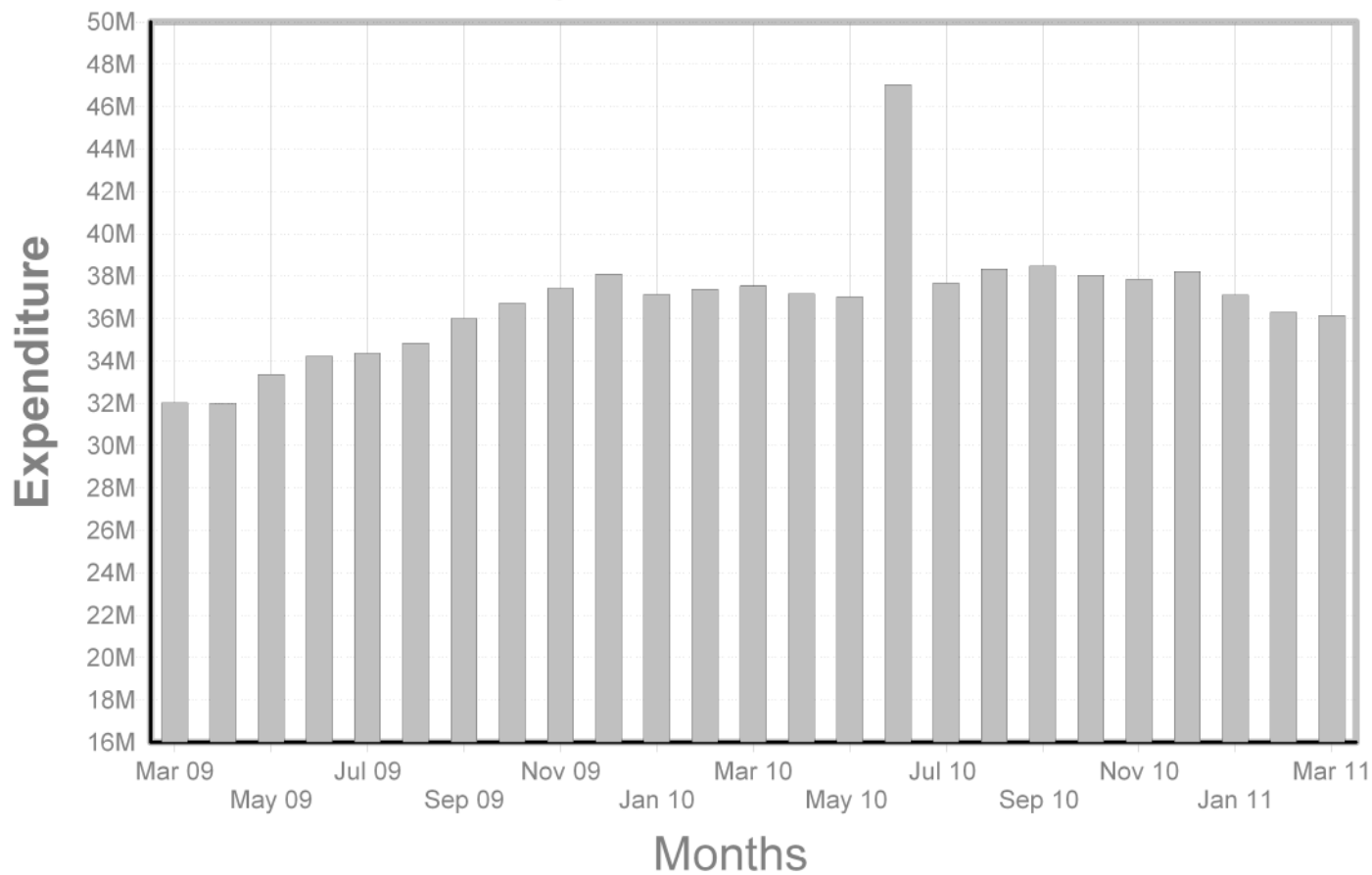
## During The Last 25 months

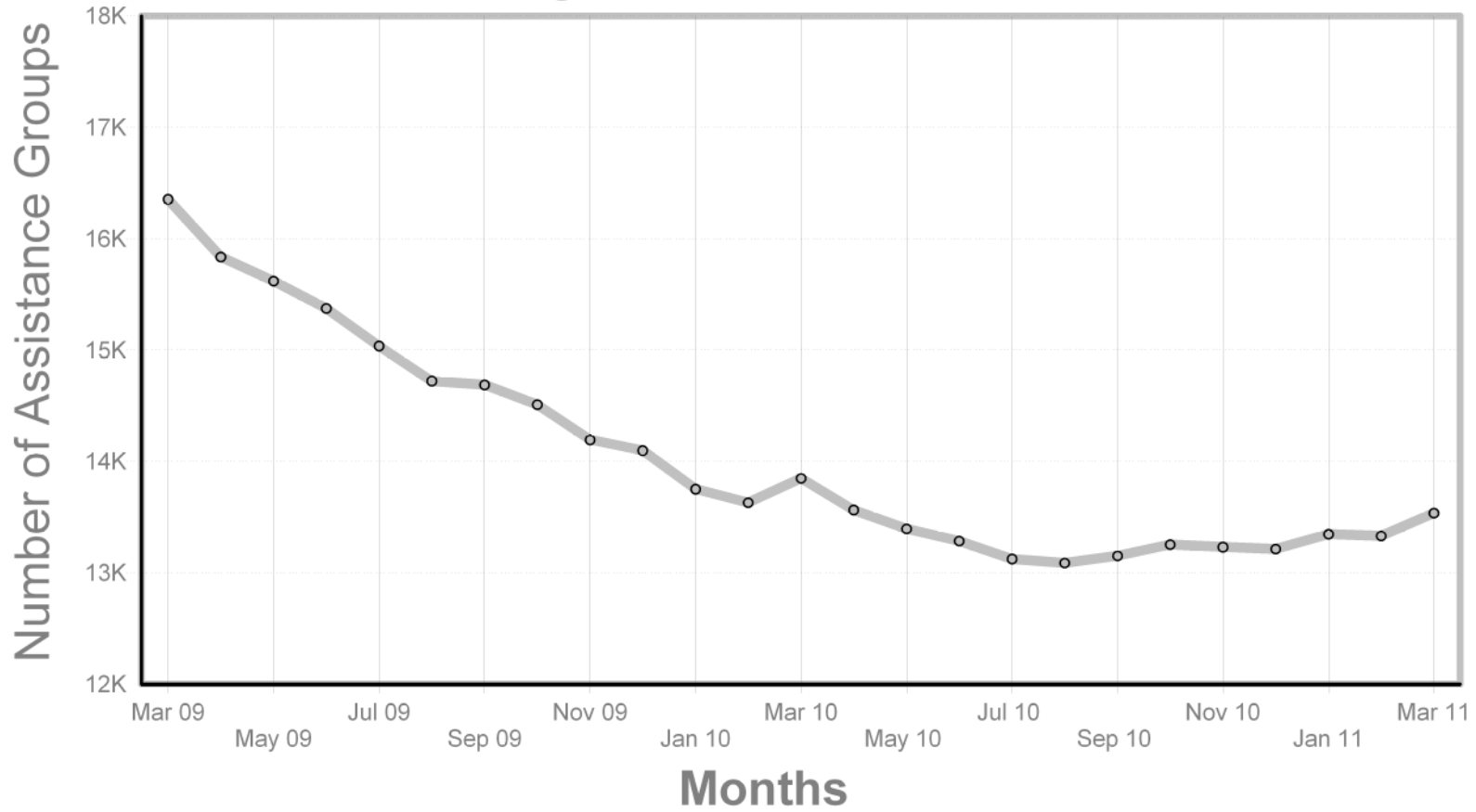

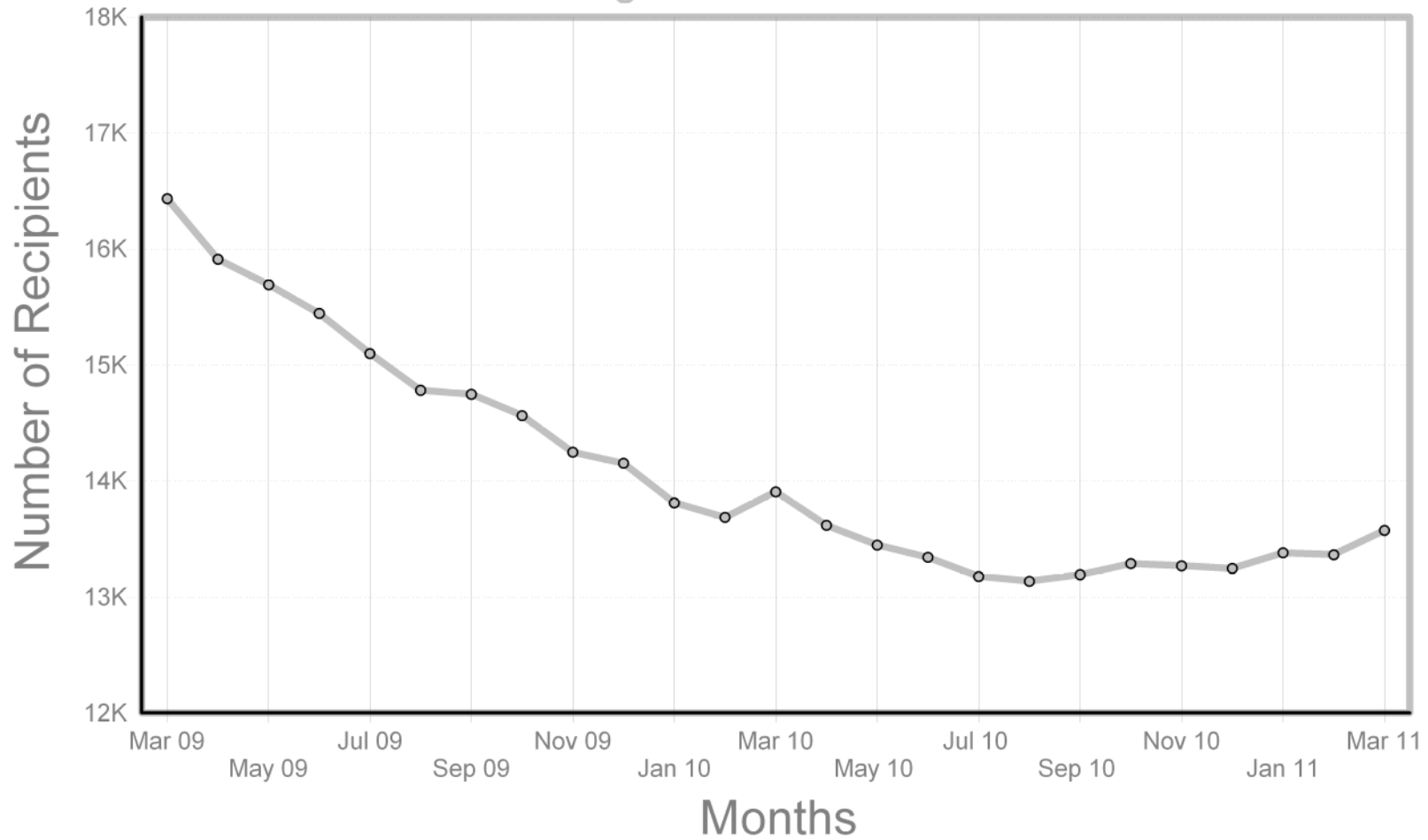

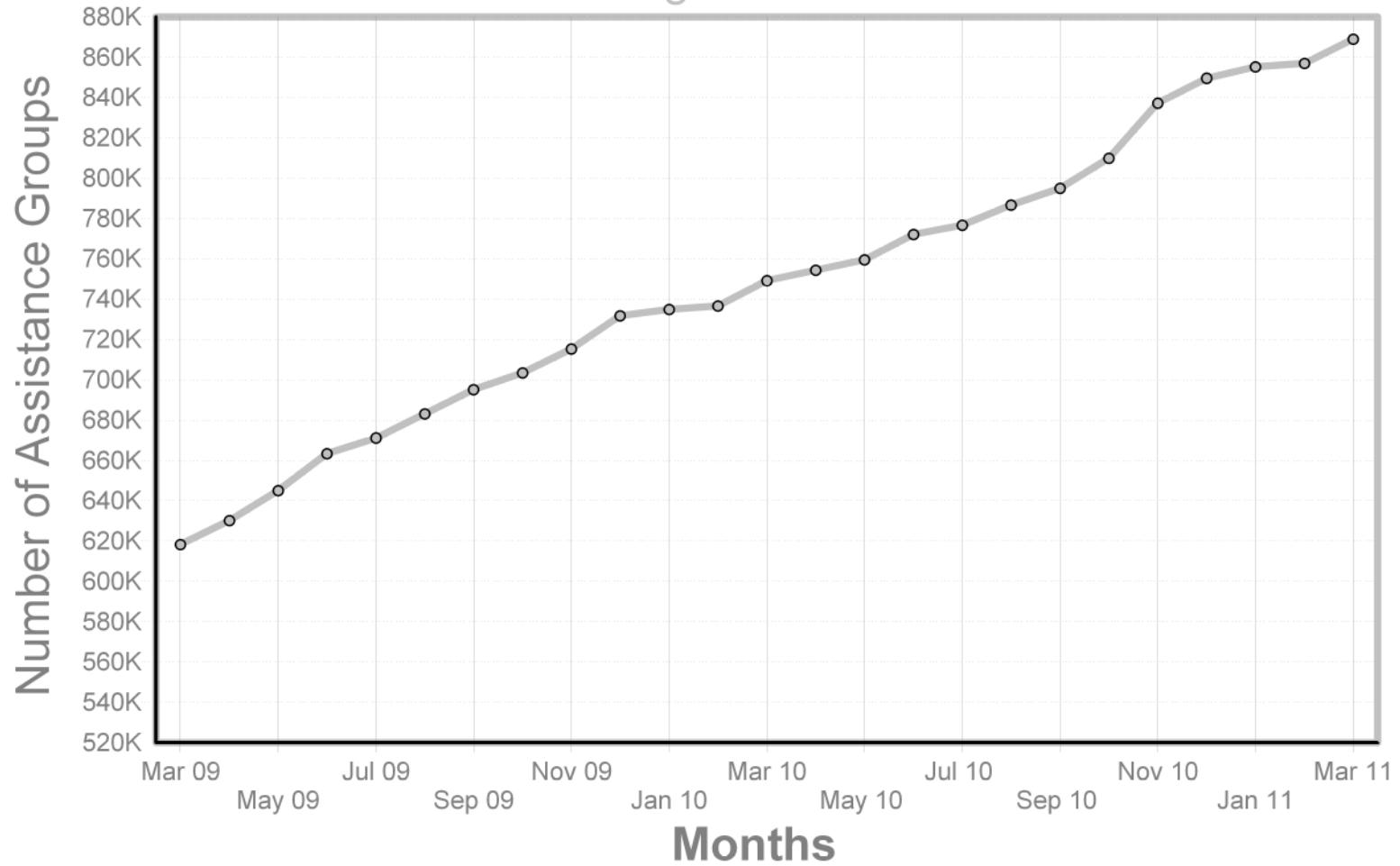

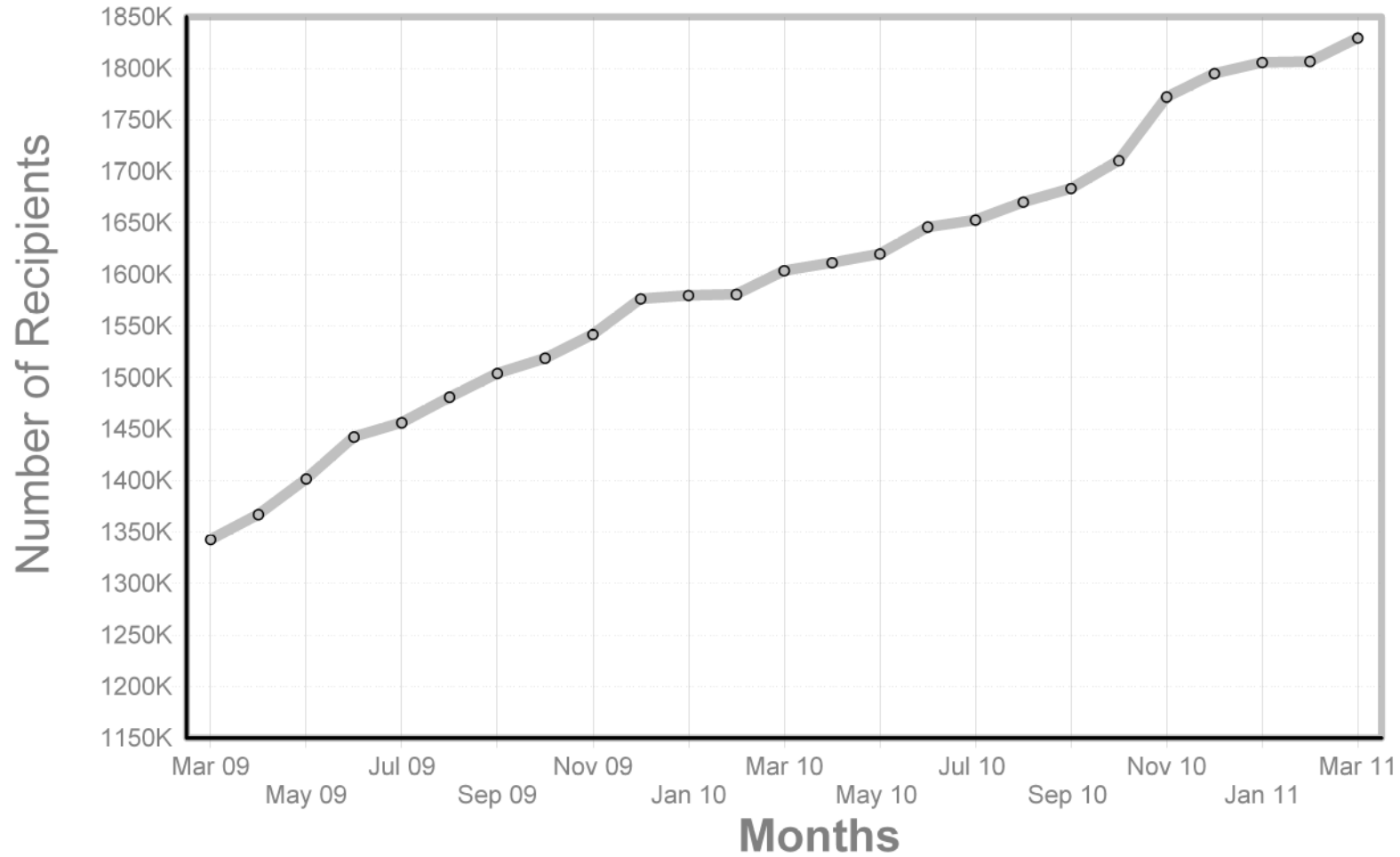
