Monthly Review of Public Assistance Statistics for April 2011

Ohio Works First (OWF)

For the month of April 2011, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 95,441; recipients totaled 214,342 and money payments totaled \$35,178,892. The percent change from March 2011 to April 2011 was -2.1% for assistance groups; -2.8% for recipients, and -2.7% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 87,885 assistance groups; 184,979 recipients, and \$31,535,844 in money payments issued for April 2011. The percent change from March 2011 to April 2011 was -1.9% for assistance groups; -2.5% for recipients, and -2.5% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U), assistance groups totaled 7,556, recipients totaled 29,363 and money payments were \$3,643,048. The percent change from March 2011 to April 2011 was -4.0% for assistance groups; -4.2% for recipients and -3.9% for money payments.

Foster Care (TITLE IV-E)

Disability Assistance (DA)

For the month of April 2011, there were 13,320 assistance groups; 13,359 recipients, and \$1,855,434 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$138.89. Total DA expenditures for medical services for April 2011 were -\$127. Medical expenses were charged for 3 recipients.

Food And Nutrition Services Benefits (FNS) (Food Stamps)


Total persons participating in the FNS benefits program during April 2011 decreased to 1,801,378 by -28,293 or -1.5% from 1,829,671 persons reported in March 2011. Households decreased by 10,768 or -1.2% over March 2011 levels. The total dollar value of FNS related benefits issued during April 2011 decreased by \$2,463,994 or -1.0% from \$255,075,685 reported in March 2011 to \$252,611,691 reported in April 2011. The average benefit issuance per person increased by \$0.82 or 0.6% from those issued in March 2011. The average benefit issuance per person increased from \$139.41 reported in March 2011 to \$140.23 reported in April 2011.




Number of OWF Combined Assistance Groups During The Last 25 months








