## Monthly Review of Public Assistance Statistics for April 2012

---

### Ohio Works First (OWF)

---

For the month of April 2012, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 77,242; recipients totaled 161,588 and money payments totaled \$28,710,398. The percent change from March 2012 to April 2012 was -2.4% for assistance groups; -3.1% for recipients, and -2.9% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 72,717 assistance groups; 144,084 recipients, and \$26,421,422 in money payments issued for April 2012. The percent change from March 2012 to April 2012 was -2.2% for assistance groups; -2.9% for recipients, and -2.7% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U), assistance groups totaled 4,525, recipients totaled 17,504 and money payments were \$2,288,976. The percent change from March 2012 to April 2012 was -5.1% for assistance groups; -4.8% for recipients and -5.9% for money payments.

### Disability Assistance (DA)

---

For the month of April 2012, there were 12,116 assistance groups; 12,152 recipients, and \$1,671,680 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$137.56.

---

### Food And Nutrition Services Benefits (FNS) (Food Stamps)

---

Total persons participating in the FNS benefits program during April 2012 decreased to 1,823,853 by 18,077 or -1.0% from 1,841,930 persons reported in March 2012. Households decreased by 6,467 or -0.7% over March 2012 levels. The total dollar value of FNS related benefits issued during April 2012 decreased by \$4,059,083 or -1.6% from \$253,988,778 reported in March 2012 to \$249,929,695 reported in April 2012. The average benefit issuance per person decreased by \$0.86 or -0.6% from those issued in March 2012. The average benefit issuance per person






## No. of OWF Combined Assistance Groups During The Last 25 months








