Monthly Review of Public Assistance Statistics for May 2012

Ohio Works First (OWF)

For the month of May 2012, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 76,358; recipients totaled 159,034 and money payments totaled \$28,450,603. The percent change from April 2012 to May 2012 was -1.1% for assistance groups; -1.6% for recipients, and -0.9% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 71,957 assistance groups; 142,075 recipients, and \$26,199,828 in money payments issued for May 2012. The percent change from April 2012 to May 2012 was -1.0% for assistance groups; -1.4% for recipients, and -0.8% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U), assistance groups totaled 4,401, recipients totaled 16,959 and money payments were \$2,250,775. The percent change from April 2012 to May 2012 was -2.7% for assistance groups; -3.1% for recipients and -1.7% for money payments.

Foster Care (TITLE IV-E)

Disability Assistance (DA)

For the month of May 2012, there were 12,190 assistance groups; 12,225 recipients, and \$1,745,763 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$142.80.

Food And Nutrition Services Benefits (FNS) (Food Stamps)


Total persons participating in the FNS benefits program during May 2012 decreased to 1,803,334 by 20,519 or -1.1% from 1,823,853 persons reported in April 2012. Households decreased by 7,648 or -0.9% over April 2012 levels. The total dollar value of FNS related benefits issued during May 2012 decreased by \$2,567,365 or -1.0% from \$249,929,695 reported in April 2012 to \$247,362,330 reported in May 2012. The average benefit issuance per person increased by \$0.14 or 0.1% from those issued in April 2012. The average benefit issuance per person




No. of OWF Combined Assistance Groups During The Last 25 months








