Monthly Review of Public Assistance Statistics for September 2012

Ohio Works First (OWF)

For the month of September 2012, OWF-Combined assistance groups totaled 70,411; recipients totaled 143,318 and money payments totaled \$26,173,026. The percent change from August 2012 to September 2012 was -2.7% for assistance groups; -3.3% for recipients, and -3.0% for money payments. For OWF- Regular (OWF-R) there were 66,998 assistance groups; 130,037 recipients, and \$24,415,501 in money payments issued for September 2012. The percent change from August 2012 to September 2012 was -2.6% for assistance groups; -3.1% for recipients, and -2.8% for money payments. For OWF-Unemployed (OWF-U), assistance groups totaled 3,413, recipients totaled 13,281 and money payments were \$1,867,052. The percent change from August 2012 to September 2012 was -5.6% for assistance groups; -5.9% for recipients and -5.9% for money payments.

Foster Care (TITLE IV-E)

Disability Assistance (DA)

For the month of September 2012, there were 11,577 assistance groups; 11,616 recipients, and \$1,599,699 in DA financial assistance. The average DA financial assistance per recipient was \$137.72.

Food And Nutrition Services Benefits (FNS) (Food Stamps)

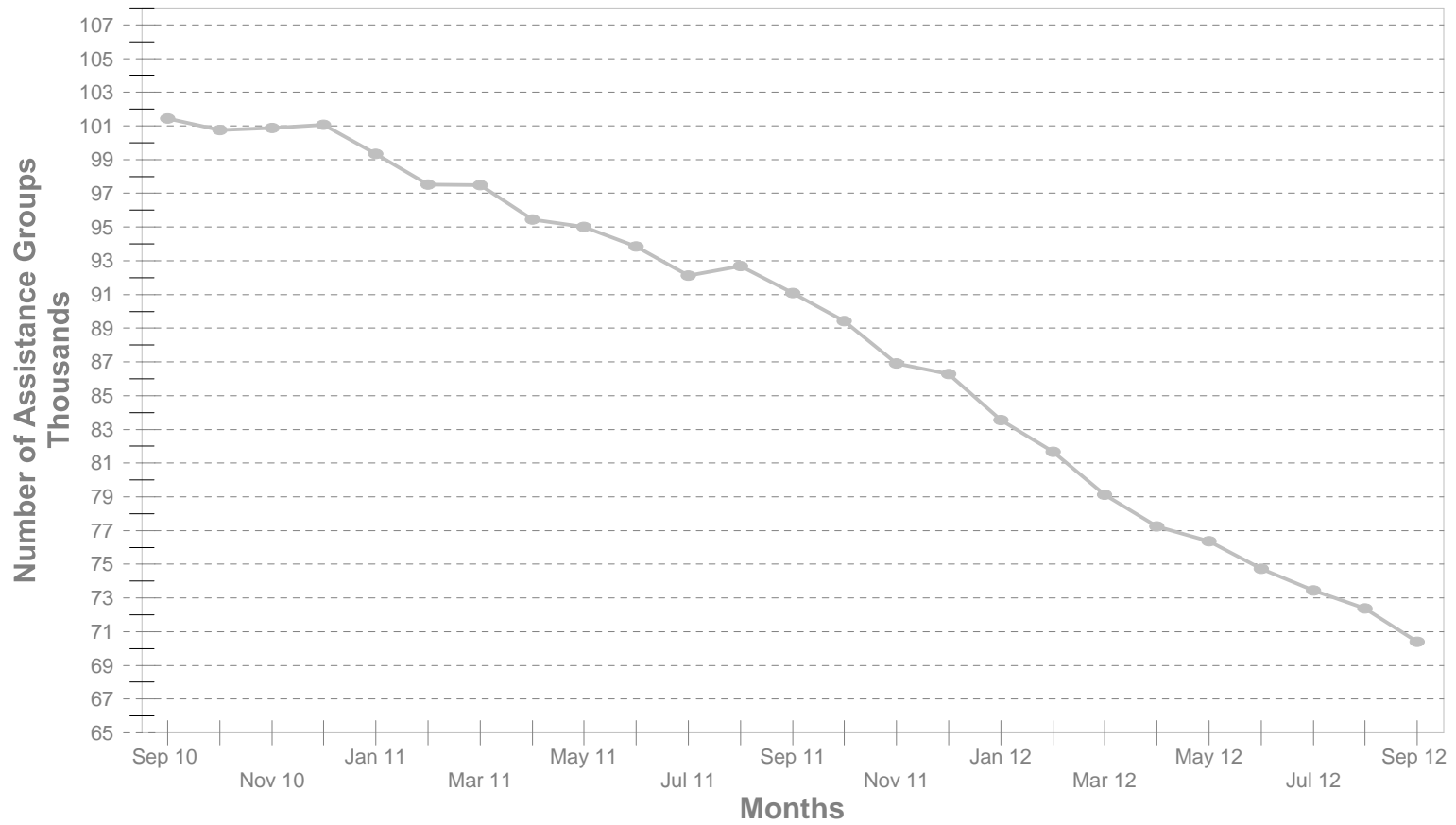
Total persons participating in the FNS benefits program during September 2012 decreased to 1,778,635 by 8,782 or -0.5% from 1,787,417 persons reported in August 2012. Households decreased by 2,714 or -0.3% over August 2012 levels. The total dollar value of FNS related benefits issued during September 2012 decreased by \$2,461,492 or -1.0% from \$247,170,720 reported in August 2012 to \$244,709,228 reported in September 2012. 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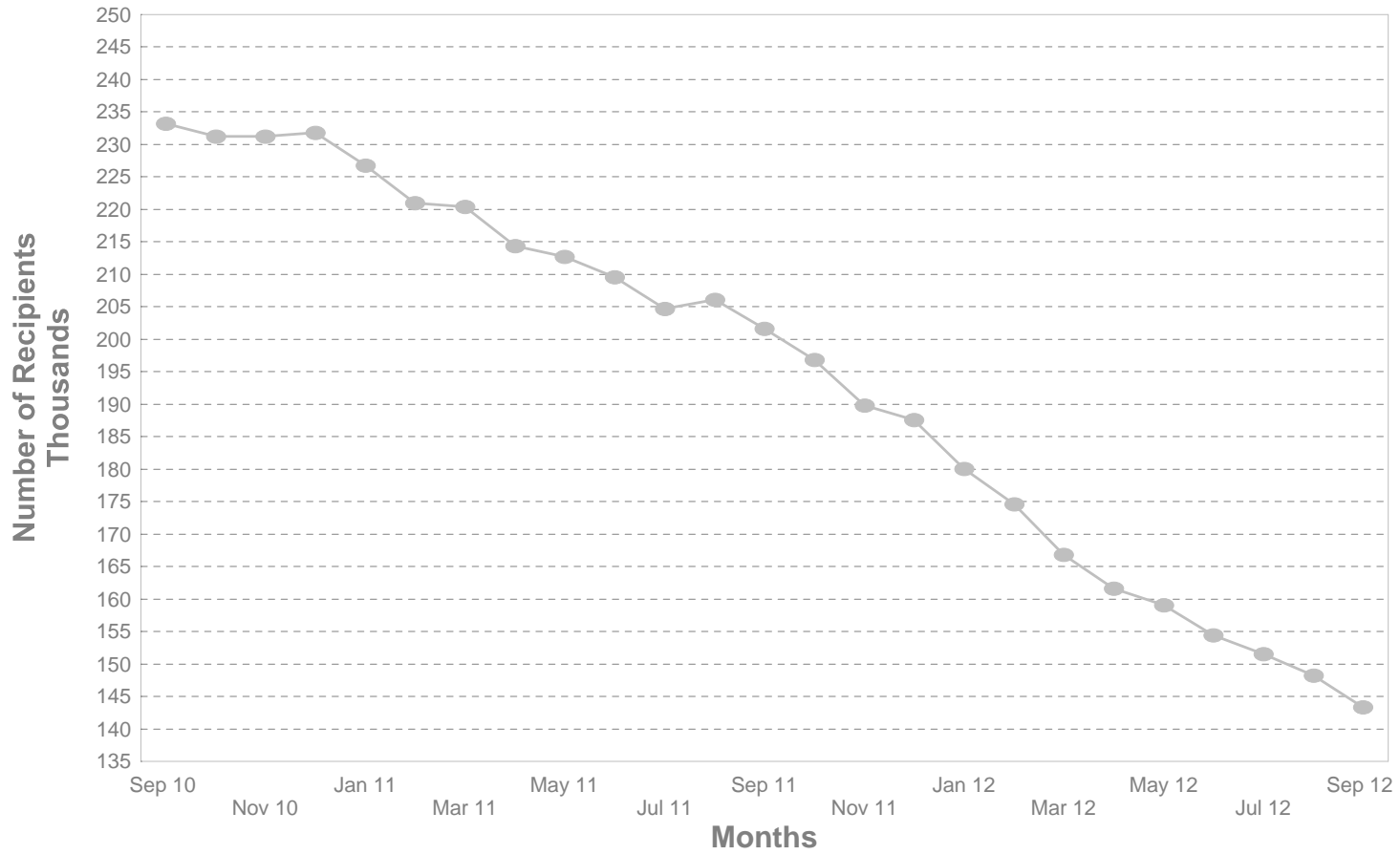

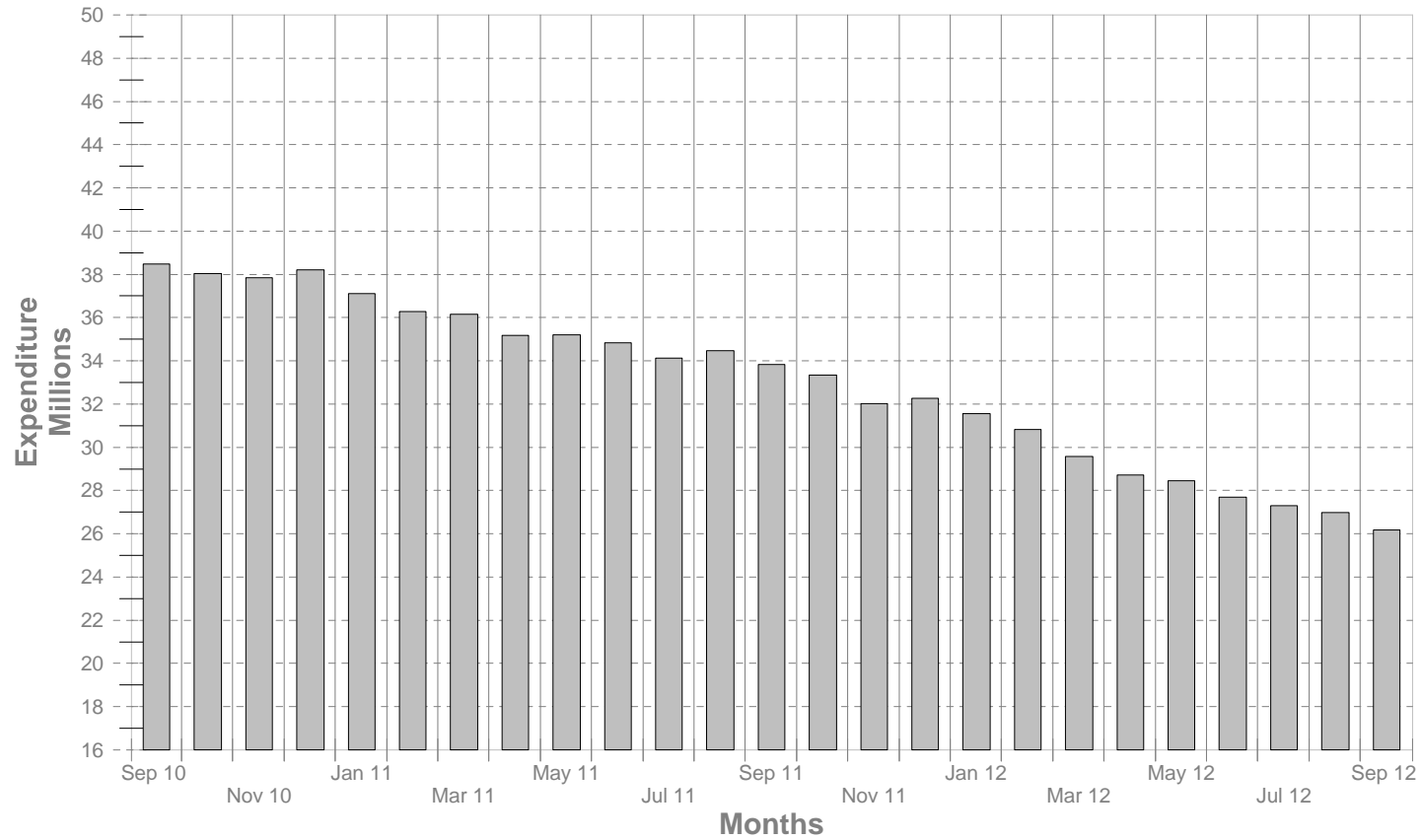
No. of OWF Combined Assistance Groups During The Last 25 months

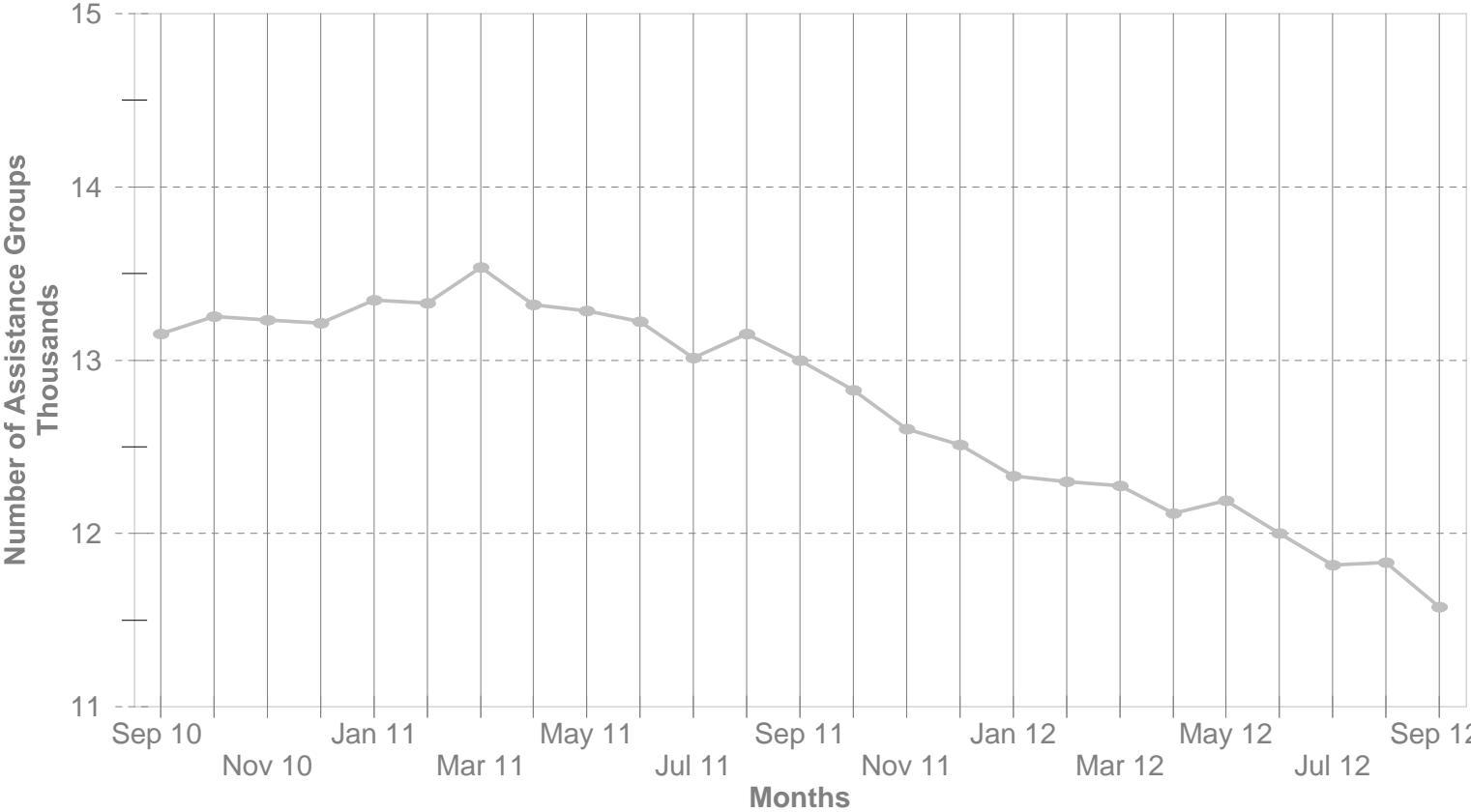

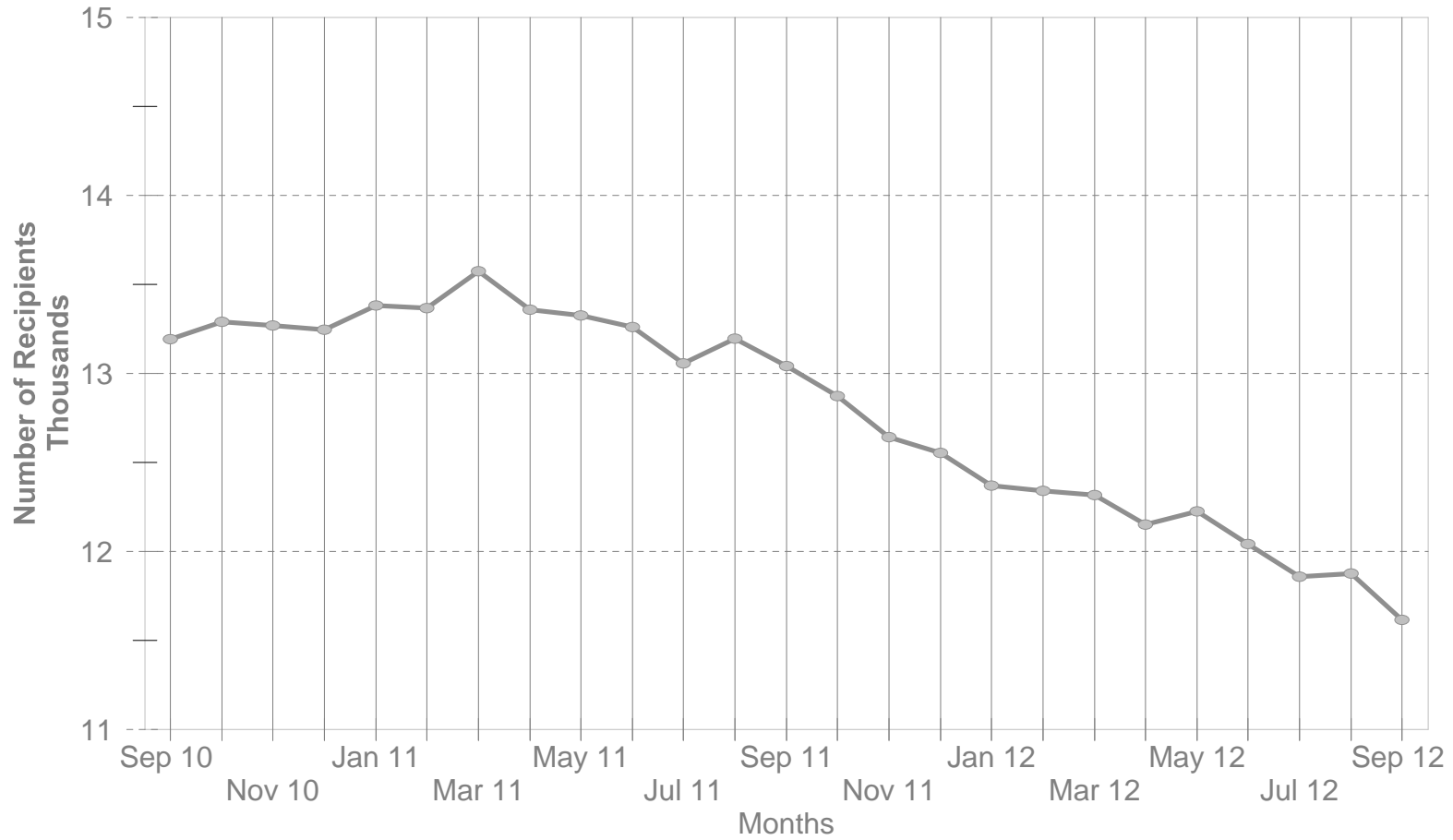

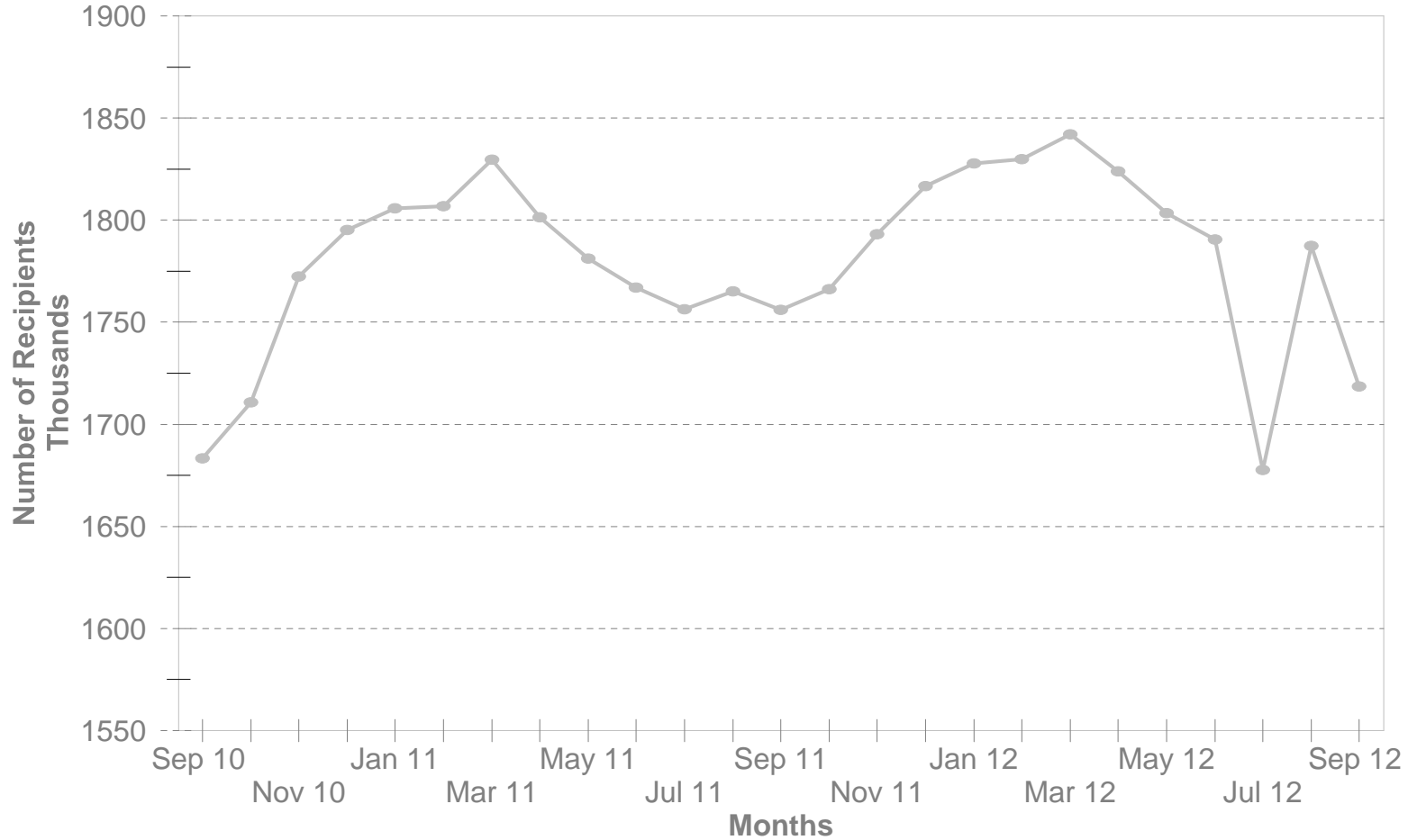
