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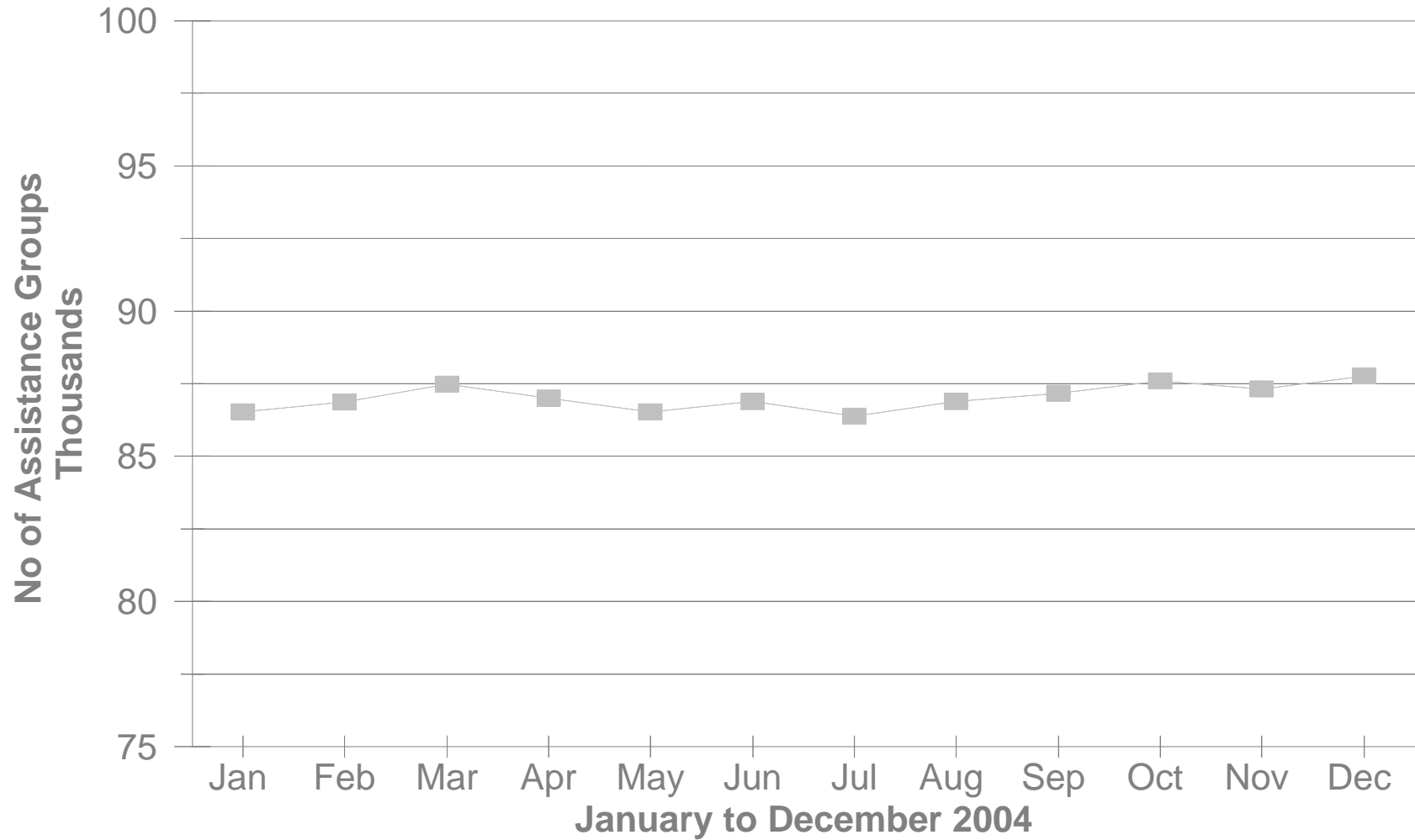

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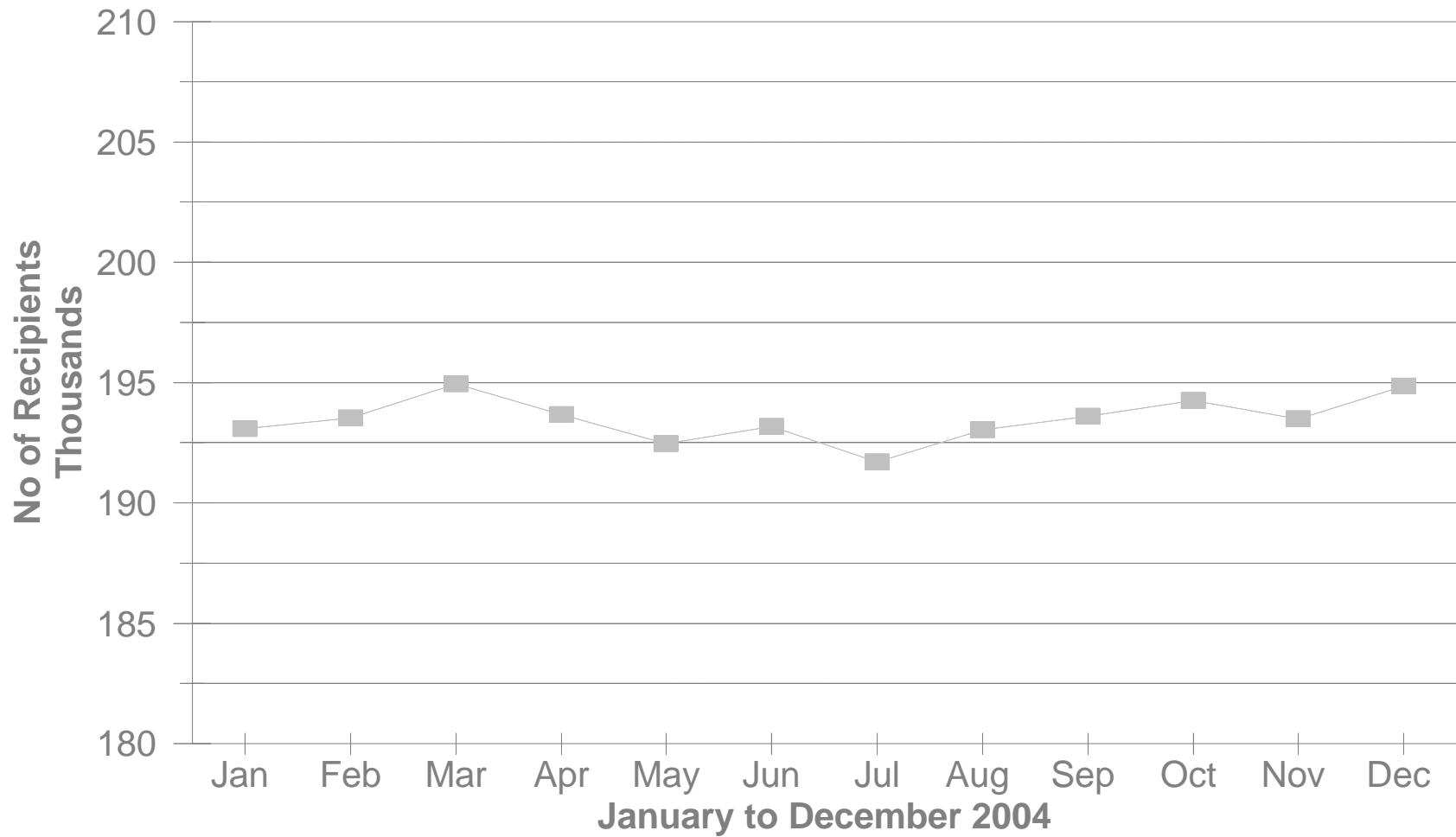

No of OWF Combined Assistance Groups During Calendar Year 2004

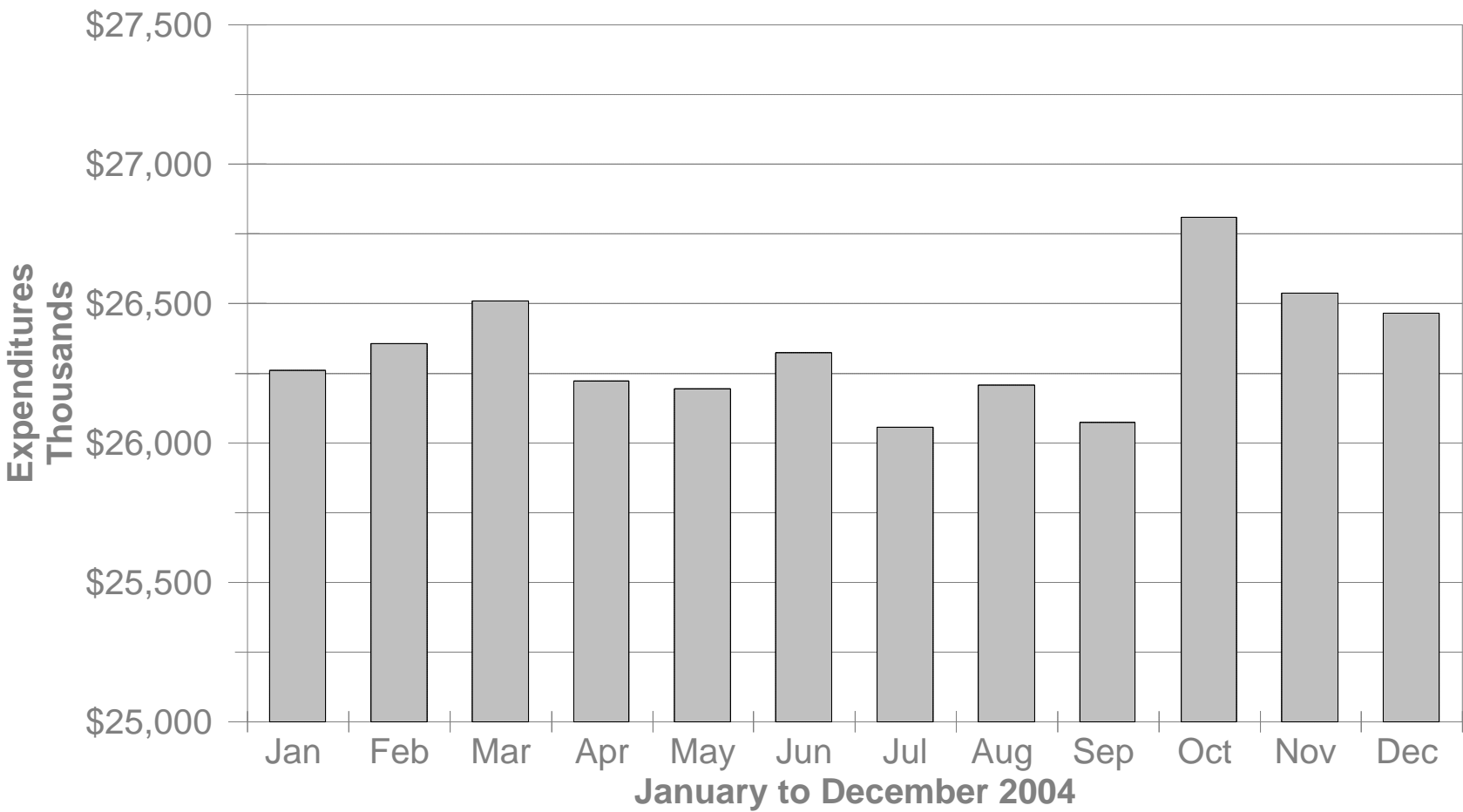


No of OWF Combined Recipients During Calendar Year 2004

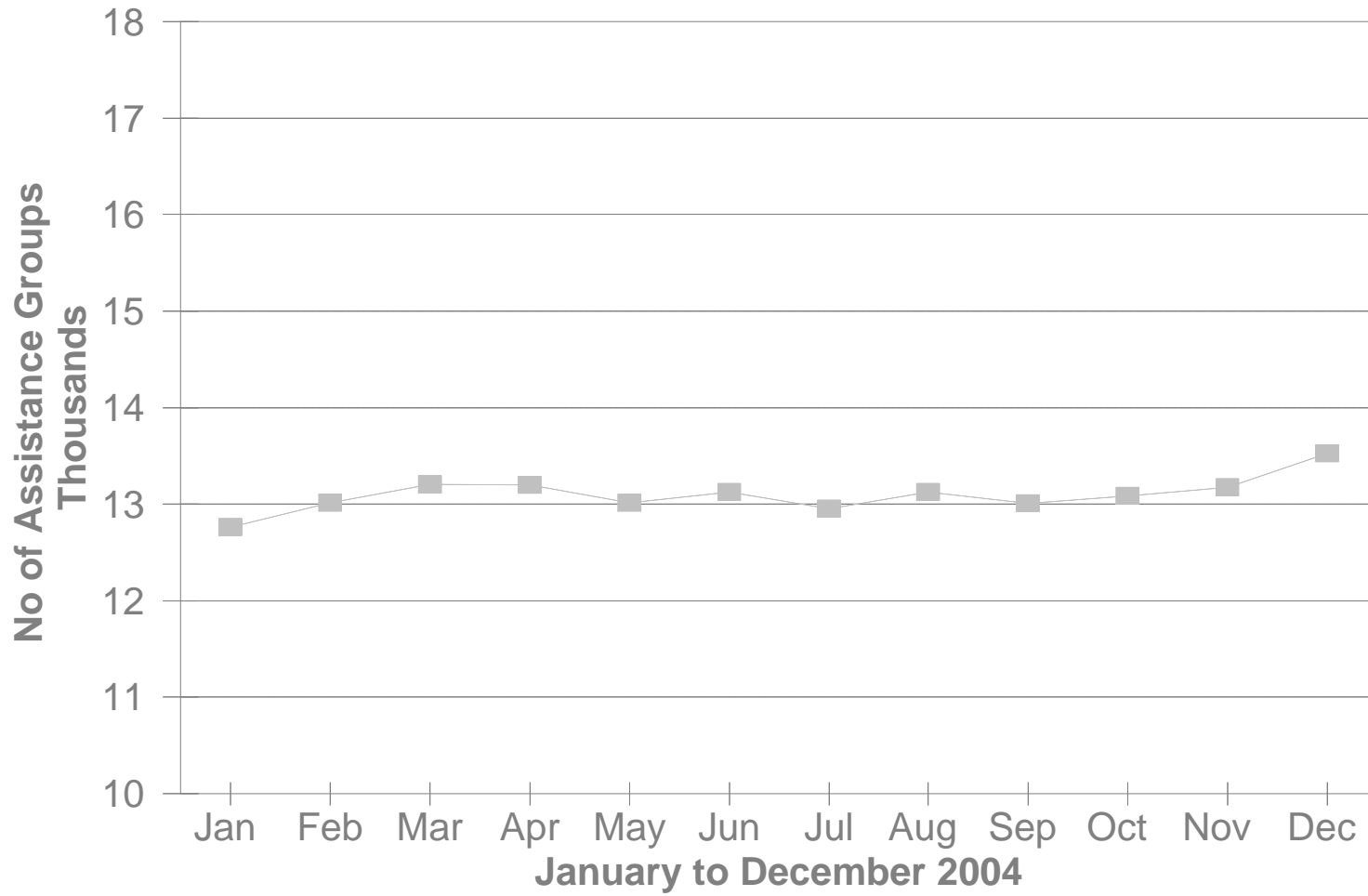

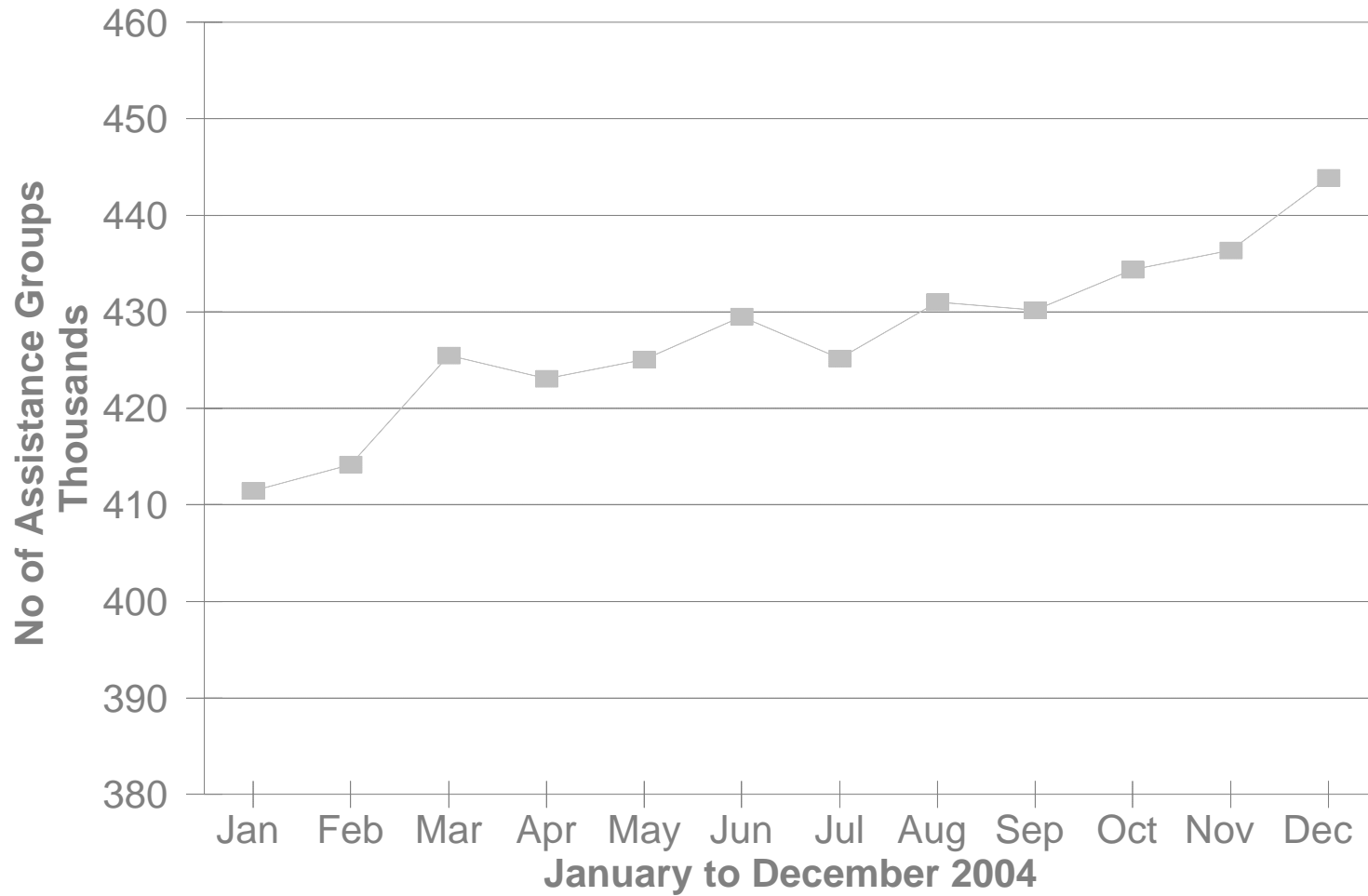

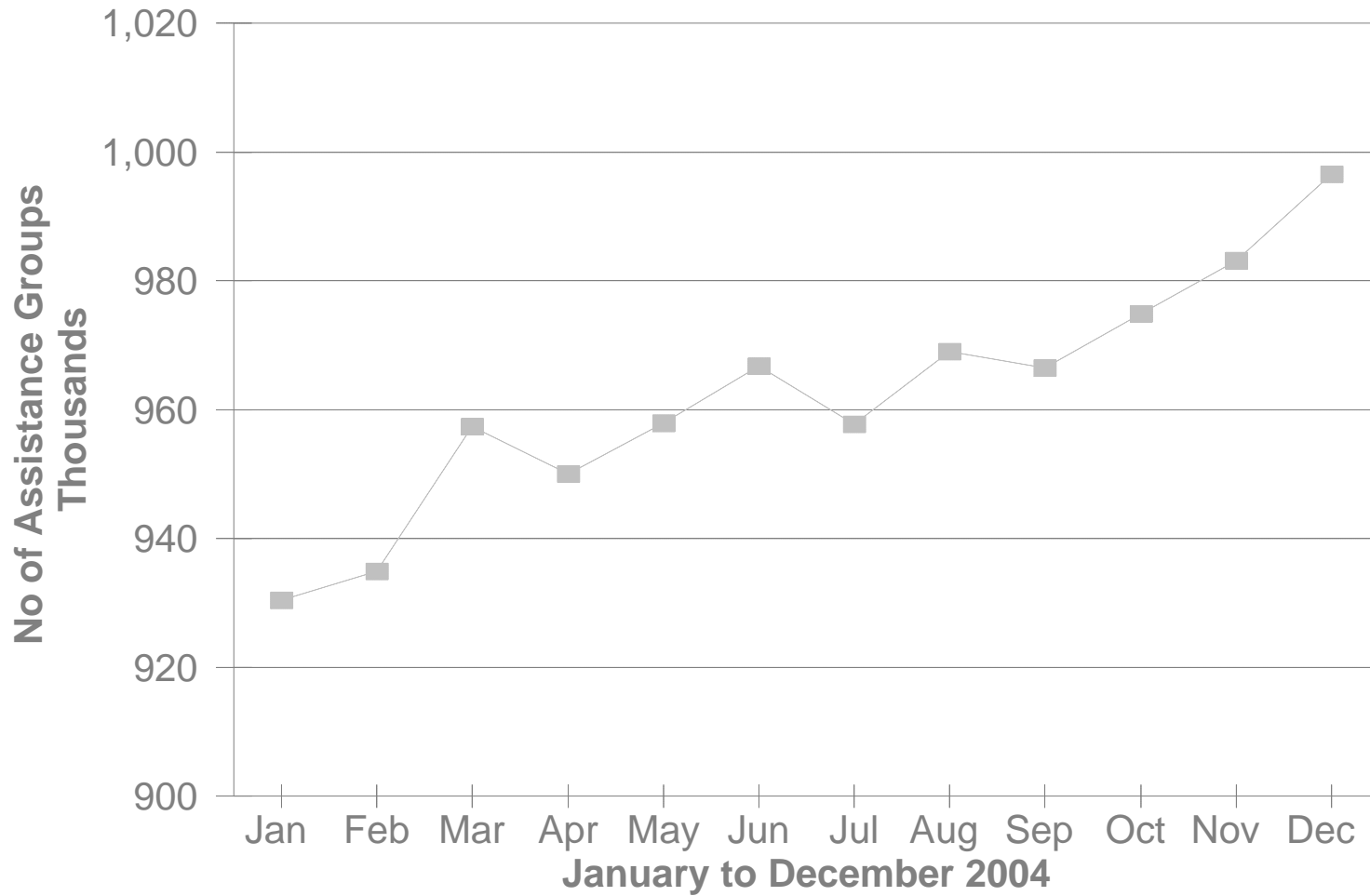
