

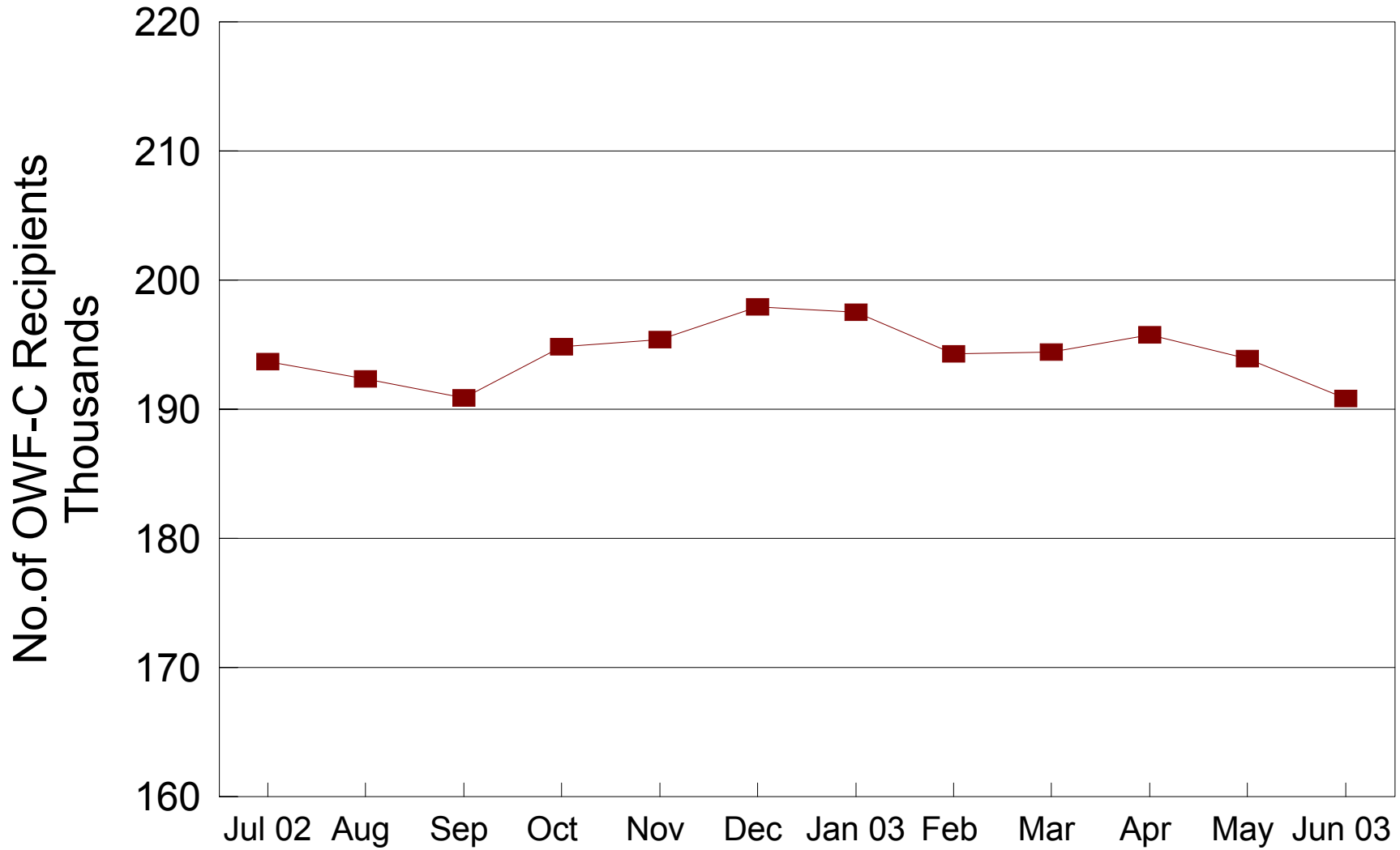

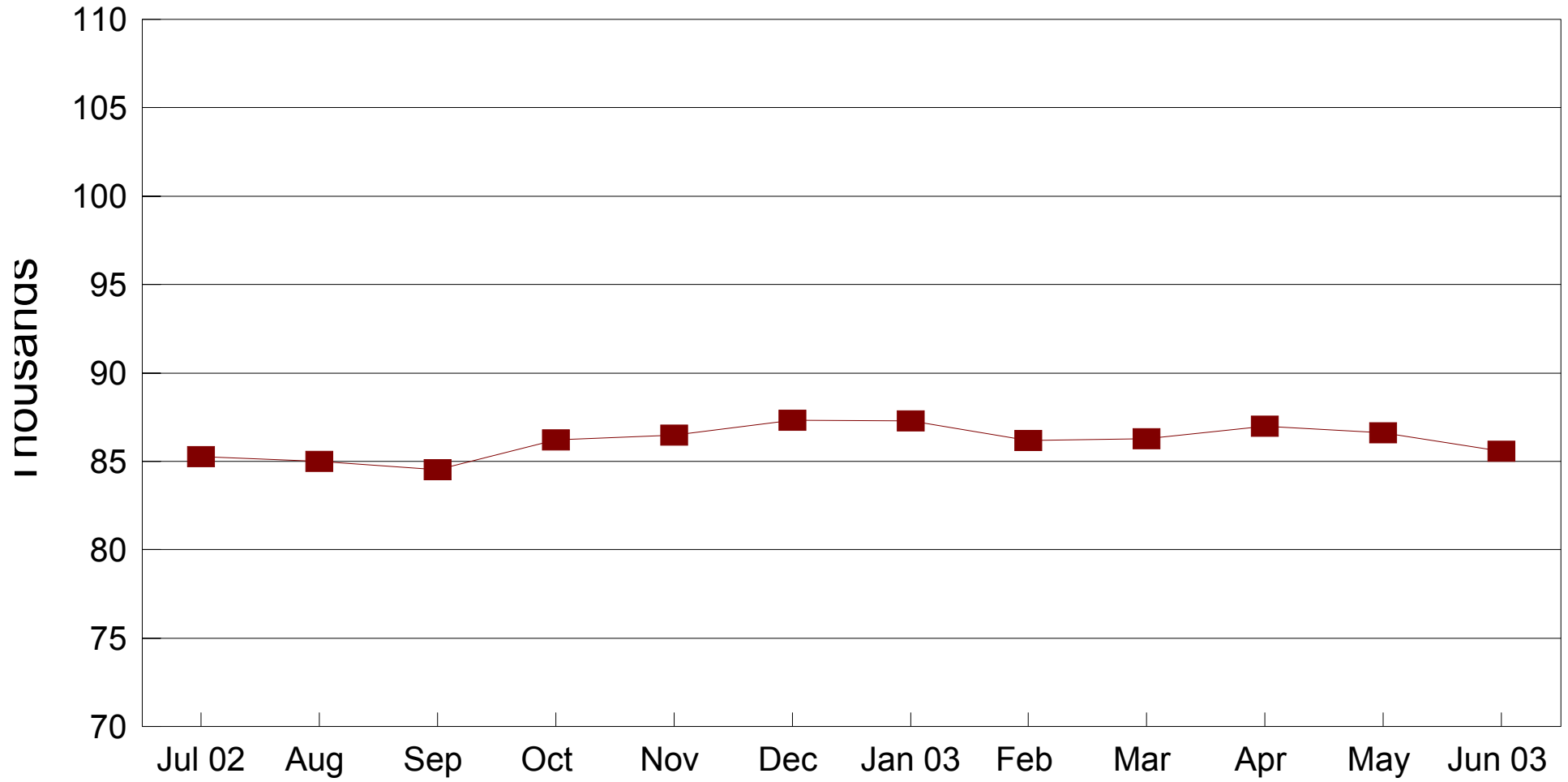

# Number of OWF-Combined Recipients During State Fiscal Year 2003



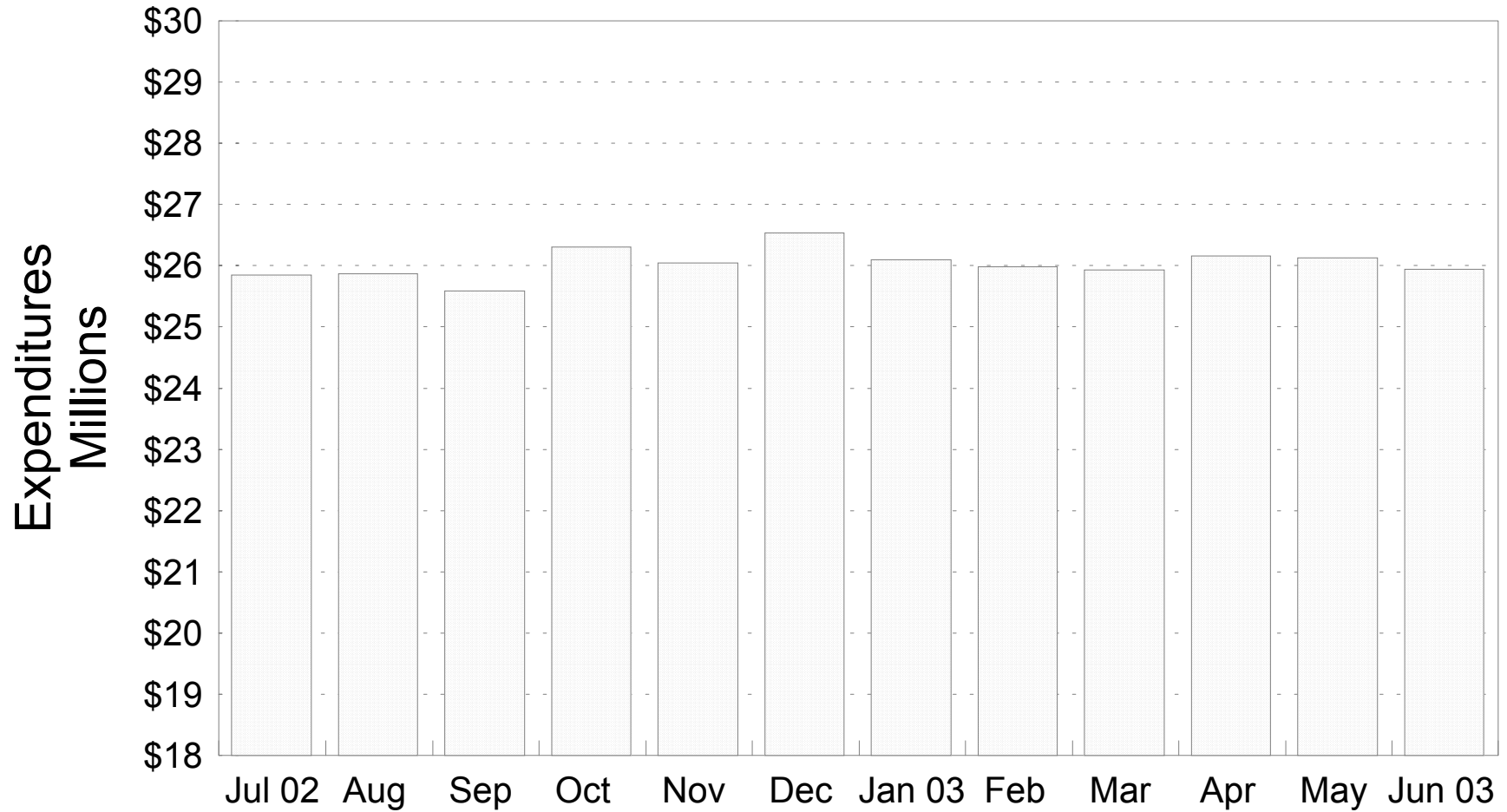
# No. of OWF-Combined Assistance Groups

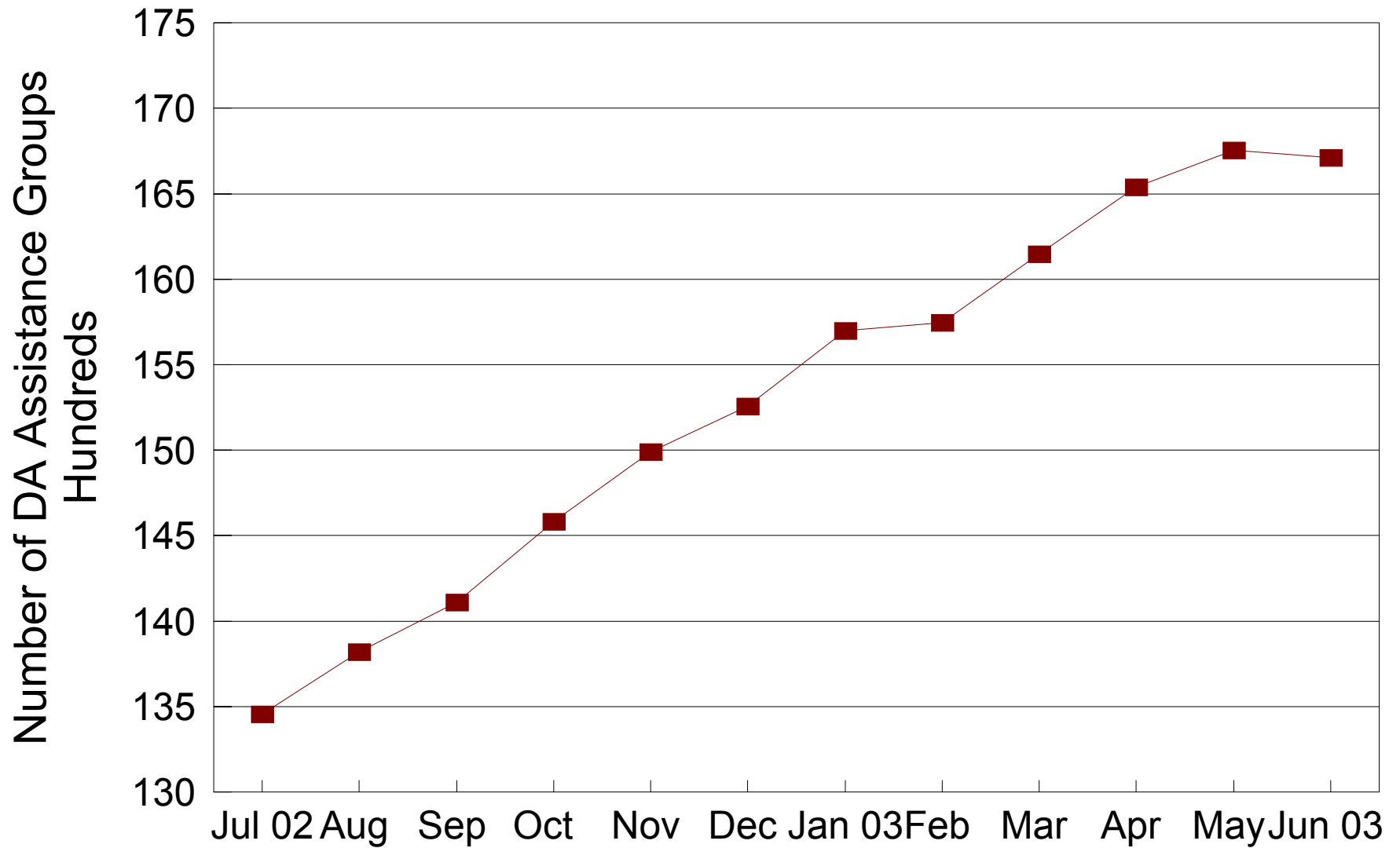

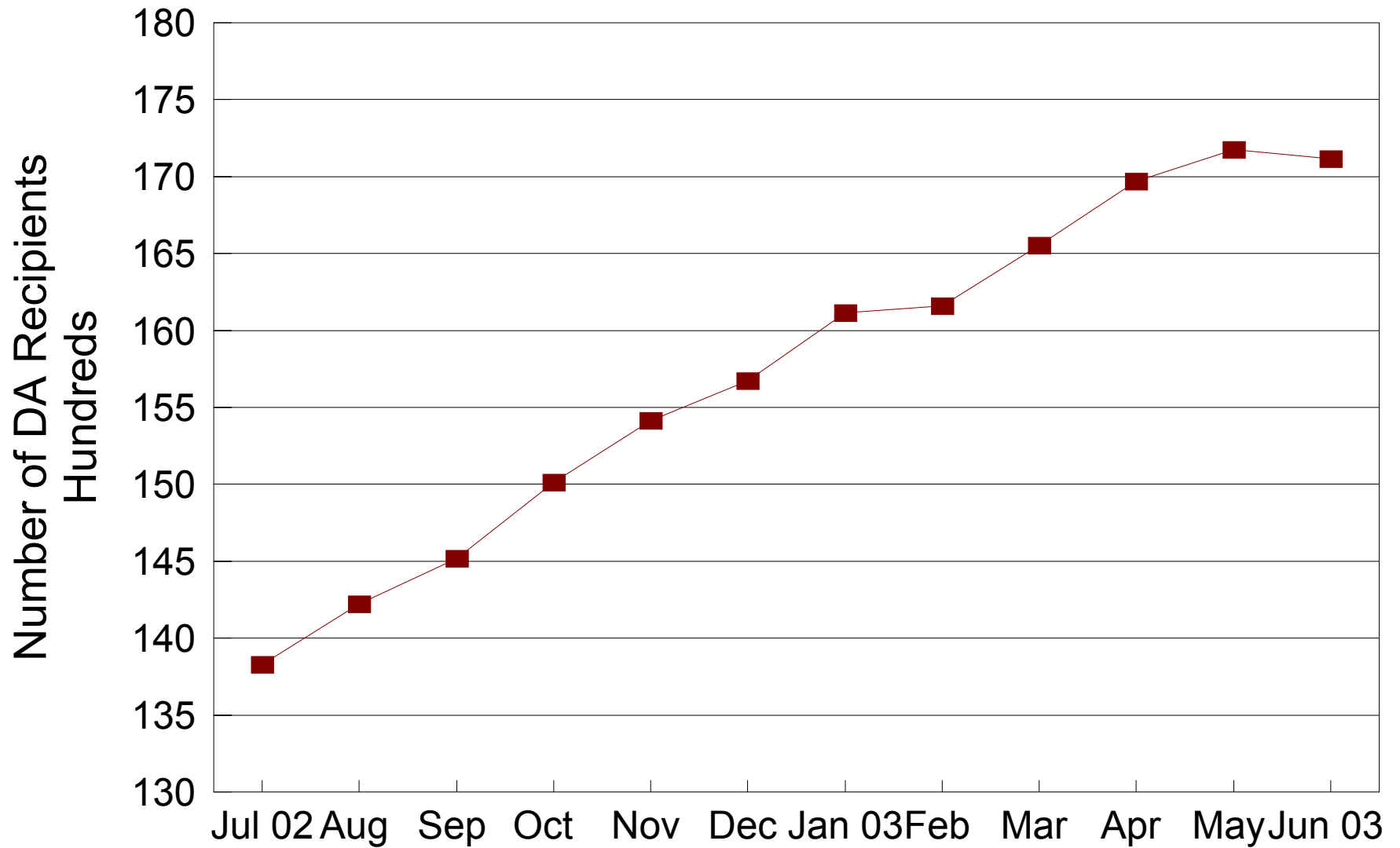
# DA Cash Assistance Groups

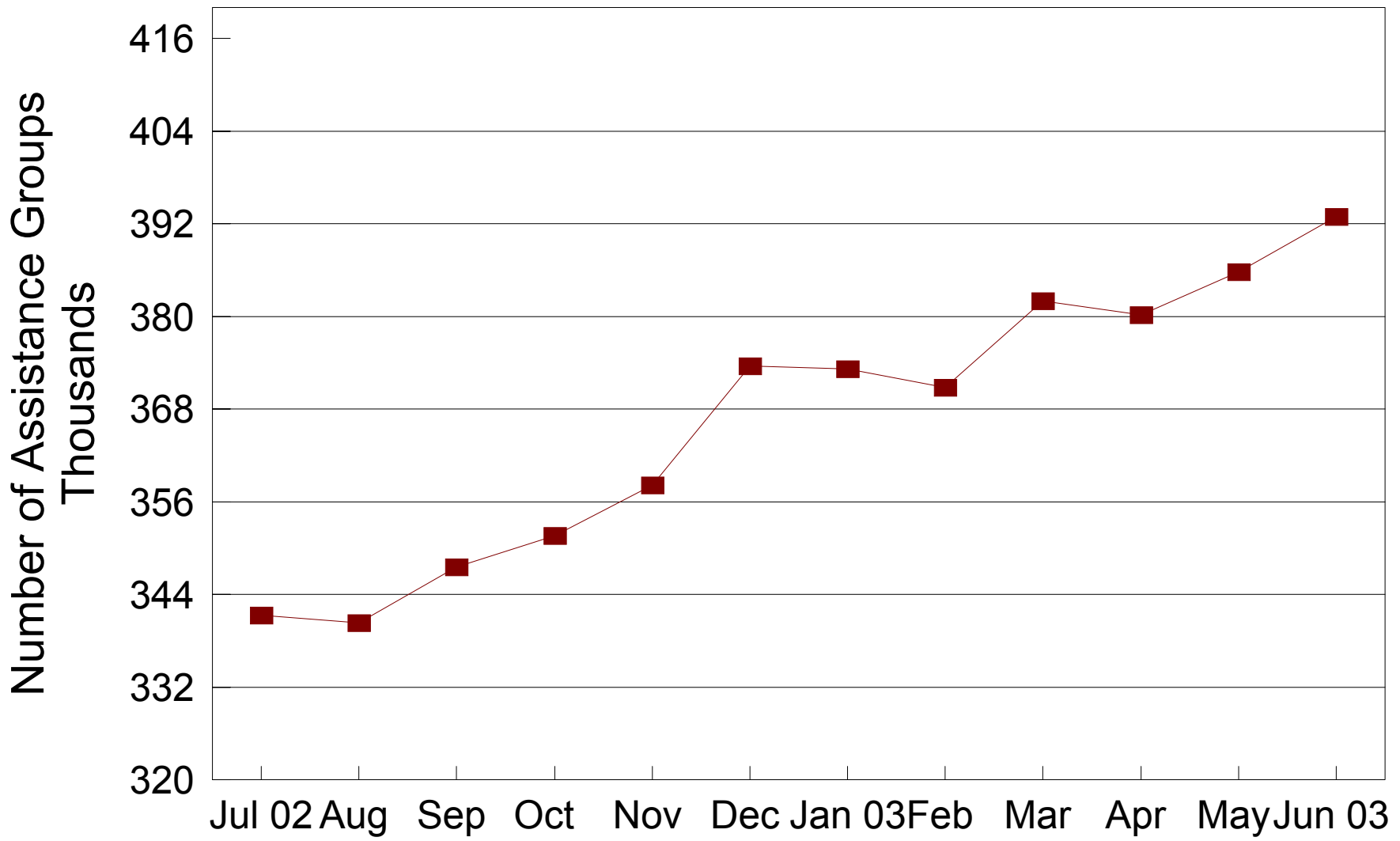

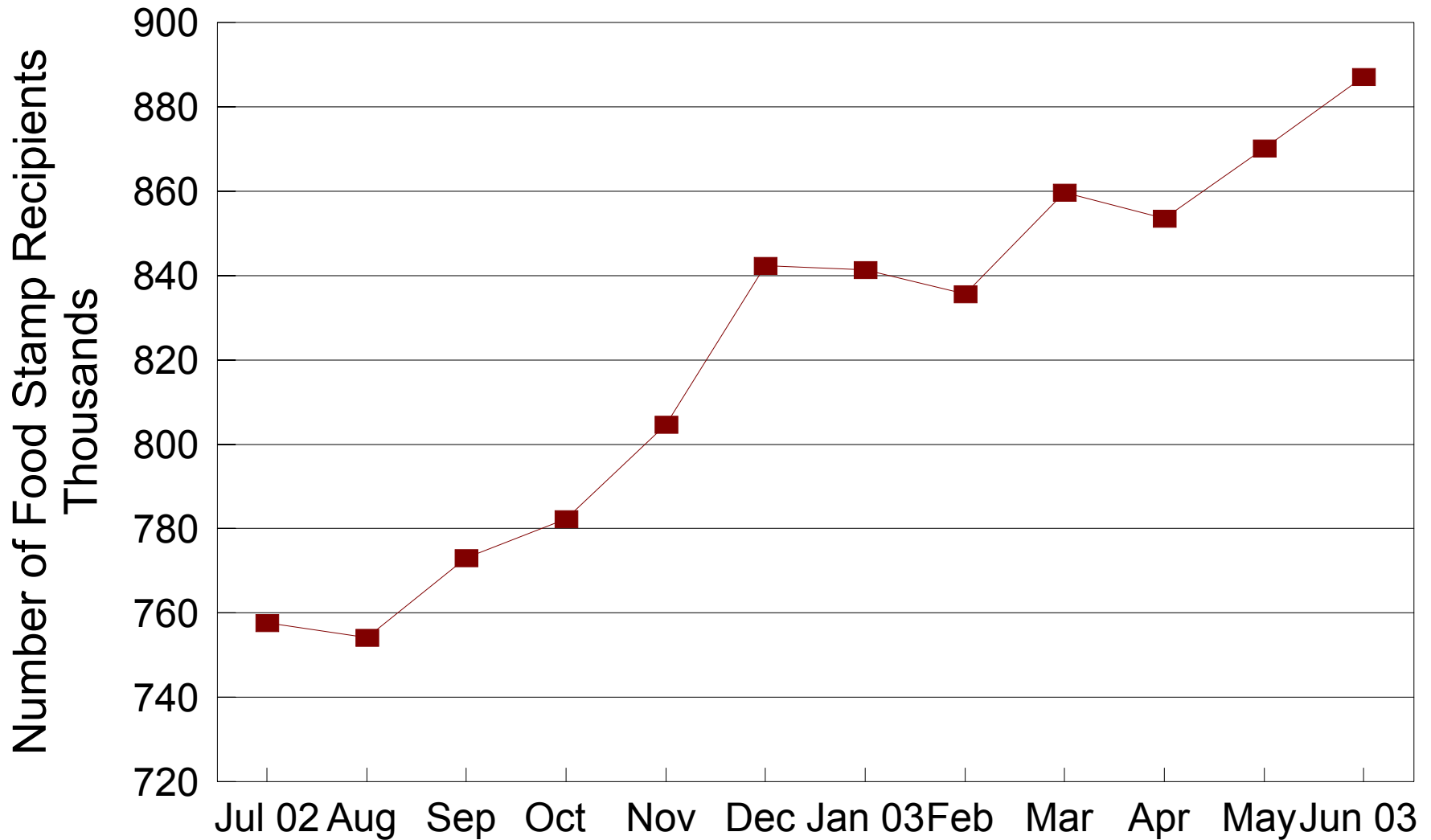
