RE: Notice of Workforce Reduction

To Whom It May Concern:

Air Wisconsin Airlines will be reducing its workforce at the following facilities effective October 1, 2020 as a result of decreased flying operations with United Airlines. This decrease in flying is reflective of the decreased travel demands within the industry due to COVID-19:

Air Wisconsin Airlines
Dayton International Airport (DAY)
3550 Hangar Drive
Vandalia, Ohio 45377

At this point in time this is a temporary layoff. The layoff time period is unknown, as it will be dependent on the increase in travel demands and United Airline's need for Air Wisconsin's flying services. The anticipated schedule for making layoffs and separations for all employees affected at these locations will be October 1, 2020, with their last day worked being September 30, 2020 or during the 14 day period beginning on that date. It may result in the layoff of approximately 47 union/represented employees. Attached is the list of job titles for the positions that will be affected and the number of employees in each position.

All of the affected employees are represented by collective bargaining agreements. The contact information for both of the unions is as follows:
