Dear Ohio Department of Job and Family Services,

General Electric with one of its manufacturing sites and HQ co-located in Evendale doing business as General Electric Aviation (the "Company") at the facility located at 1 Neumann Way Cincinnati, Ohio 45215, has made the decision to permanently lay off 208 full-time salaried employees on July 24, 2020.

The Company previously laid off nine full-time salaried employees on April 17, 165 full-time salaried employees on May 31, and 147 full-time hourly employees on June 7, 2020. Including 29 re-hired pensioners who were let go between March 22 and April 29, 2020, this amounts to a total of 558 full-time employees at the Evendale site who will have been laid off due to the COVID 19 emergency and related government orders/instructions and business circumstances that were not reasonably foreseeable. The site also permanently laid off 47 part-time employees (as "part-time" is defined under the WARN Act) between March 30 and June 3, 2020.

The job titles of affected positions and the number of affected employees in each job category will be provided to you upon request. Also, the name of each union representing the affected hourly employees, and the name and email address of the chief elected officer of each union will be provided to you upon request. Terminated employees have no rights to bump or displace other employees.

This announcement and the timetable described above are based on the best information currently available. We will inform you of any updates to these plans that will result in additional permanent layoffs.
