To Whom It May Concern:

The intent of this letter is to provide notice that Great Lakes Brewing Company will be experiencing mass layoffs and terminations. Due to unforeseeable business circumstances arising from the Coronavirus pandemic and resulting national emergency, as well as the Ohio Governor's Order closing restaurants and bars, we have made the very difficult decision to furlough approximately one hundred eleven employees, most of whom are in Ohio. Additionally, we have had to make the decision to permanently terminate five employees. We hope to rehire most, if not all, of the furloughed employees when business conditions improve. We are providing as much notice as possible to the employees, the Ohio Department of Job & Family Services, and the local elected official under these unforeseeable and difficult circumstances.

Most of the employees who will be laid off work at 2516 Market Ave., Cleveland, Ohio 44113.

The furloughs and permanent terminations will occur on or about March 31st.
