Re: WARN Notice from Greenville Technology, Inc./Moriroku-North America (FEIN [REDACTED])

Dear Rapid Response Team:

This is to notify you that as a result of the unforeseen circumstances associated with the pandemic and the announcement by the State of Ohio's Governor, Mike DeWine, instituting a stay at home order for all people and non-essential businesses requires Greenville Technology, Inc (GTI) & Moriroku-North America (MTNA) to implement temporary layoffs for an unknown duration. Pursuant to the Worker Adjustment Retraining and Notification Act, 29 U.S.C. § 2101, this is notice that MTNA, including GTI, announced mass layoffs on March 20, 2020 at its locations at GTI/MTNA - 5755 State Route 571 Greenville, OH 45331; GTI – 3511 West 73rd Street Anderson, IN 46013; and MTNA – 15000 Industrial Parkway Marysville, OH 43040. The effective date of the temporary employee layoffs is March 23, 2020. The layoff also affected temporary employees at the Greenville and Anderson locations that are employed through First Call Staffing located at 1620 S. Scatterfield Road Anderson, IN 46016.

Due to the sudden and unexpected nature of the virus outbreak, the timing of the government mandated shutdown announcement, and its adverse effect on our business operations, we were prevented from providing notice sooner but provided this notice to affected employees as soon as was practicable, which was on or before Friday, March 20, 2020.

The remaining information required by 20 C.F.R. §639.7(e) is maintained and available on site upon request.
