Subject: WARN question

We have more than 100 FT workers. The initial layoff started on March 23 and was to last less than 6 months and affected more than 50 employees. We sent a WARN notice. Unfortunately, the effect of the COVID-19 pandemic has continued to delay the original recall date. On April 17, we permanently laid off 5 salaried associates. Due to the deepening economic impact on our business and our business forecast we have had to permanently layoff 39 hourly associates who were part of the temporary layoff. It is our hope that we recall the associates who remain on temporary layoff before 6 months have passed. Is a separate WARN notice required for the 44 associates affected by permanent layoff?
