Dear Rapid Response Unit:

This letter is being issued in accordance with the Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act (WARN) in order to notify you that **Mitec Powertrain, Inc.** and **Mitec Automotive, Inc. (collectively, "Mitec")** are permanently closing their facility located in Findlay, OH 45840 on a date that will be greater than 60 days following the date of this notice. This will result in the layoff of 186 employees.

Mitec is not part of a union.

The closure is a result of business being transferred from Mitec's largest customer to another supplier, who is moving the production lines to Mexico and Canada. A petition for TAA certification has been filed with the U.S. Department of Labor.

All affected employees have been notified.

Bumping rights do not exist.
