Dear Rapid Response Team:

This is to notify you that as a result of the unforeseen circumstances associated with the pandemic and the declaration of a National Emergency due to the COVID-19, in order to sustain our business, we will be implementing temporary layoffs for an unknown duration. Pursuant to the Worker Adjustment Retraining and Notification Act, 29 U.S.C. § 2101, this is notice that the Rock & Roll Hall of Fame plans to announce mass layoffs on April 12, 2020 located at 1100 Rock and Roll Boulevard, Cleveland, Ohio 44114. The effective date of the first and last employee layoffs is April 12, 2020. The anticipated schedule of employee separations is to layoff the 108 employees effective April 12, 2020.

Due to the sudden and unexpected nature of the virus outbreak and its adverse effect on our business operations, we were prevented from providing notice sooner and are providing this notice to affected employees as soon as practicable.
