Re: Mass Layoff Notice

Dear Sir or Madam:

I am writing to notify you that SugarCreek Packing Co. ("SugarCreek") recently conducted a mass layoff at its Dayton Plant, located at 4249 Beerman Avenue, Dayton, OH 45417. The layoffs took place between March 26, 2020, and April 6, 2020. In total, 129 employees were laid off during that time frame; however, a portion of the layoffs were only temporary and 35 of those employees have been rehired this week.

All layoffs were due to unforeseeable business changes related to COVID-19. No additional layoffs are planned at this time but, given the unpredictable business climate during the COVID-19 pandemic, this is subject to change. Letters were sent to these employees providing information on how to file for unemployment benefits and included a copy of the "Mass Layoff Instruction Sheet" provided on the ODJFS Website.
